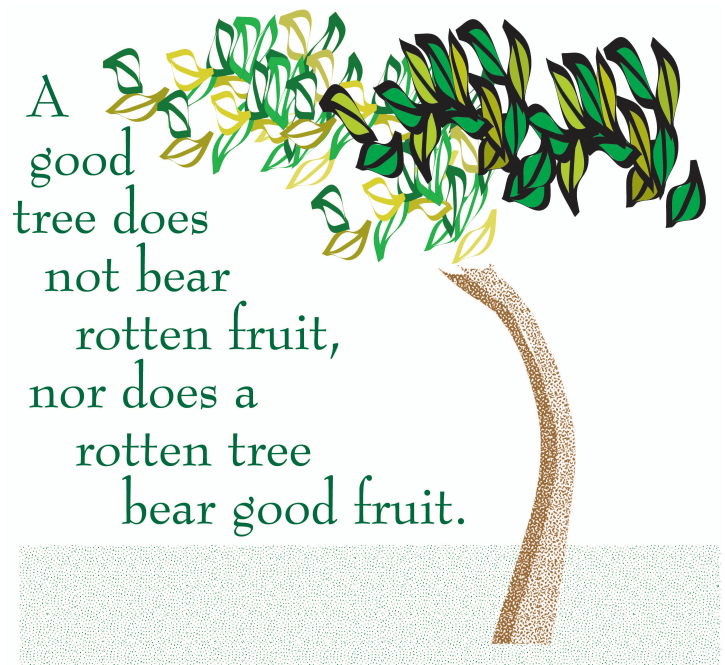

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

February 27, 2022

Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Lk 6:39-45

Jesus told his disciples a parable, "Can a blind person guide a blind person? Will not both fall into a pit? No disciple is superior to the teacher; but when fully trained, every disciple will be like his teacher. Why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own? How can you say to your brother, 'Brother, let me remove that splinter in your eye, 'when you do not even notice the wooden beam in your own eye? You hypocrite! Remove the wooden beam from your eye first; then you will see clearly to remove the splinter in your brother's eye.

"A good tree does not bear rotten fruit, nor does a rotten tree bear good fruit. For every tree is known by its own fruit. For people do not pick figs from thornbushes, nor do they gather grapes from brambles. A good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good, but an evil person out of a store of evil produces evil; for from the fullness of the heart the mouth speaks."

Reflection Questions

- What reminder does Jesus give to His disciples?
- What is one desire of a disciple? What would you say should be the one goal of every disciple?
- If you do not forgive others, how does it affect your relationships? How does it affect you and your heart for others?
- What does it mean to "be like Jesus?" Why is this important? What should be the one goal and desire of every follower of Jesus? Pray that others might see Jesus in you this week.

Ash Wednesday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members from age 14 onwards. Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses.

We invite you to join us for the Stations of the Cross every Friday during Lent at 7pm. We will gather in the Parish Hall. It is a beautiful opportunity for prayer and reflection on Jesus' ultimate sacrifice of Himself.

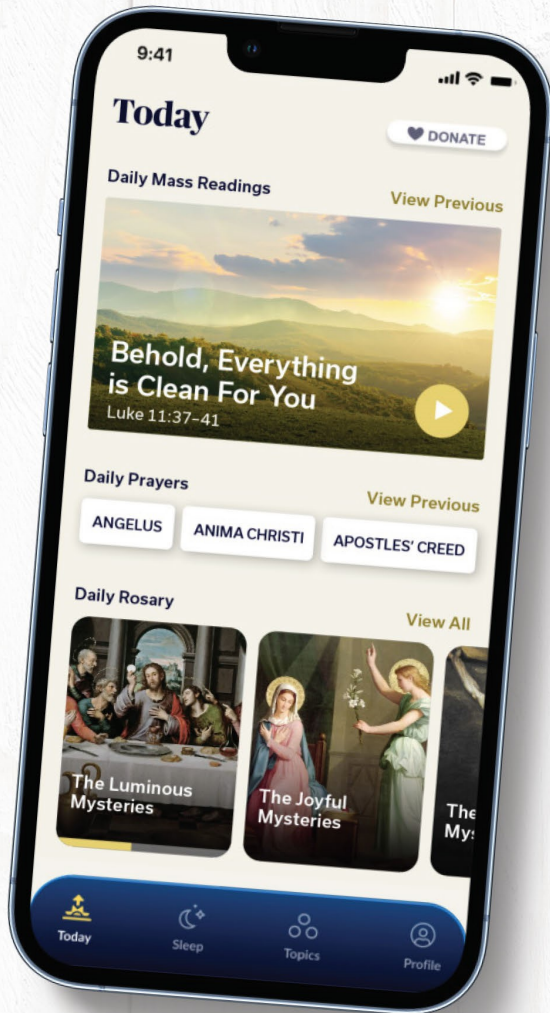
What is a 4x4x48?
