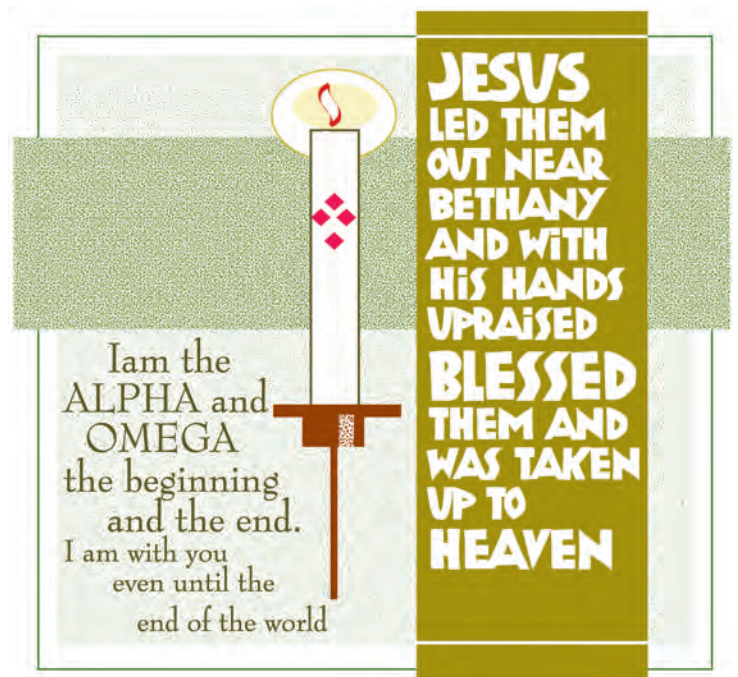

I would like to bring to your attention three items, each of which has to do with bishops.

First, last weekend we learned of the passing of **Bishop Emil Wcela**, a retired auxiliary bishop of our Diocese. Bishop Wcela was a brilliant scripture scholar and a sought-after speaker and retreat director, who served in a variety of leadership positions during his many years as a priest and bishop in our diocese. We pray that the Lord will receive His faithful servant into eternal life and reward him for his dedication to the Church.



Second, next weekend is the culmination of the Easter Season with the celebration of Pentecost. As we recall the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles gathered in the Upper Room with the Blessed Mother, we will have three people receive the sacrament of Confirmation. **Bishop William Murphy**, our retired Ordinary, will preside at the noon Mass on Sunday and will confer the sacrament on those who have been preparing with our dedicated RCIA team. Please keep our candidates in your prayers and plan on joining us for the noon Mass to welcome back Bishop Murphy to St. Gerard's and to celebrate with those who are completing their initiation into the Church.

Finally, every few years a large group of bishops gathers in Rome to discuss important matters within the Church and to offer counsel to the Holy Father. These meetings, called a **Synod of Bishops**, have been happening regularly since the close of the Second Vatican Council. Most recently, Pope Francis has asked the bishops throughout the world to hold meetings on a local level to see how we, the People of God, feel on a range of issues – our participation in the life of our local parish and the wider church; how we might reach those on the peripheries of the Church to draw them in more deeply to her work; what areas of needed growth we perceive; and how we can better journey with the human family. A couple of weeks ago, I held one of these meetings here at our parish with members of our Parish Council and Finance Committee. However, each parishioner has an opportunity to participate in this process by completing a survey created by our Diocese. You can access it at www.drvcsynod.com/survey.

As we approach Pentecost, may we open our hearts anew to the power of the Holy Spirit so that we can deepen our commitment to Christ and His Church!

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

June 5, 2022

Pentecost Sunday

Jn 7:37-39

On the last and greatest day of the feast, Jesus stood up and exclaimed, "Let anyone who thirsts come to me and drink. As Scripture says:

Rivers of living water will flow from within him who believes in me."

He said this in reference to the Spirit that those who came to believe in him were to receive. There was, of course, no Spirit yet, because Jesus had not yet been glorified.

Reflection Questions

- The feast of Pentecost celebrates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon Jesus' first disciples. This same Holy Spirit is still with us. After breathing upon them and giving them the gift of the Holy Spirit, what does Jesus tell his disciples to do?
- Just as Jesus sent his disciples to forgive the sins of others, so too we are sent to bring peace to the world. We also have been given the gift of the Holy Spirit to help us with this task. How might the Holy Spirit lead you to help bring peace to situations of conflict?





HOW WILL YOU GET INVOLVED?

1. The Background:

- January 22, 1973: Roe v Wade decision of the Supreme Court ushered in the era of abortion on demand in the United States.
- 2018: Mississippi passed a law protecting unborn children after 15 weeks of gestation, when the baby has a heartbeat, eyes that open, ears that hear, and can move and kick. The law was challenged and the case, known as Dobbs v Jackson Women's Health Organization, is being heard by the Supreme Court.
- Dobbs v Jackson is a landmark case that could potentially overturn the decision of Roe v Wade. The possibility for future laws protecting the unborn hangs in the balance.
- December 1, 2021 oral arguments for the case will be heard. A decision is expected in June 2022.

2. Our Response:

- People of every faith are coming together in a united effort to pray and fast for this intention in the coming months. www.prayfordobbs.com
- For the past 49 years, the infamous date of January 22 has been one of solemn prayer and remembrance for the tragedy of legalized abortion in this country.
- In these next crucial 9 months, from October until June let us make the 22nd of each month a special day of prayer and fasting for the Dobbs case, in the hopes that on its 50th anniversary (Jan 22, 2023) Roe v Wade will have been finally overturned.

3. Ideas for your Parish or Family:

- Encourage your pastor to celebrate the "Mass for Giving Thanks to God for the Gift of Human Life" at all the daily Masses in your parish on the 22nd of each month.
- Host a special Mass, Rosary, or Holy Hour for Life on the 22nd of each month.
- Limit yourself to one meal and two smaller meals on that day, or fast from social media, videos, music or something else you like on the 22nd.
- Pray the rosary together with your family or a group of friends for this intention.

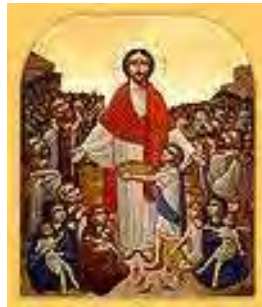

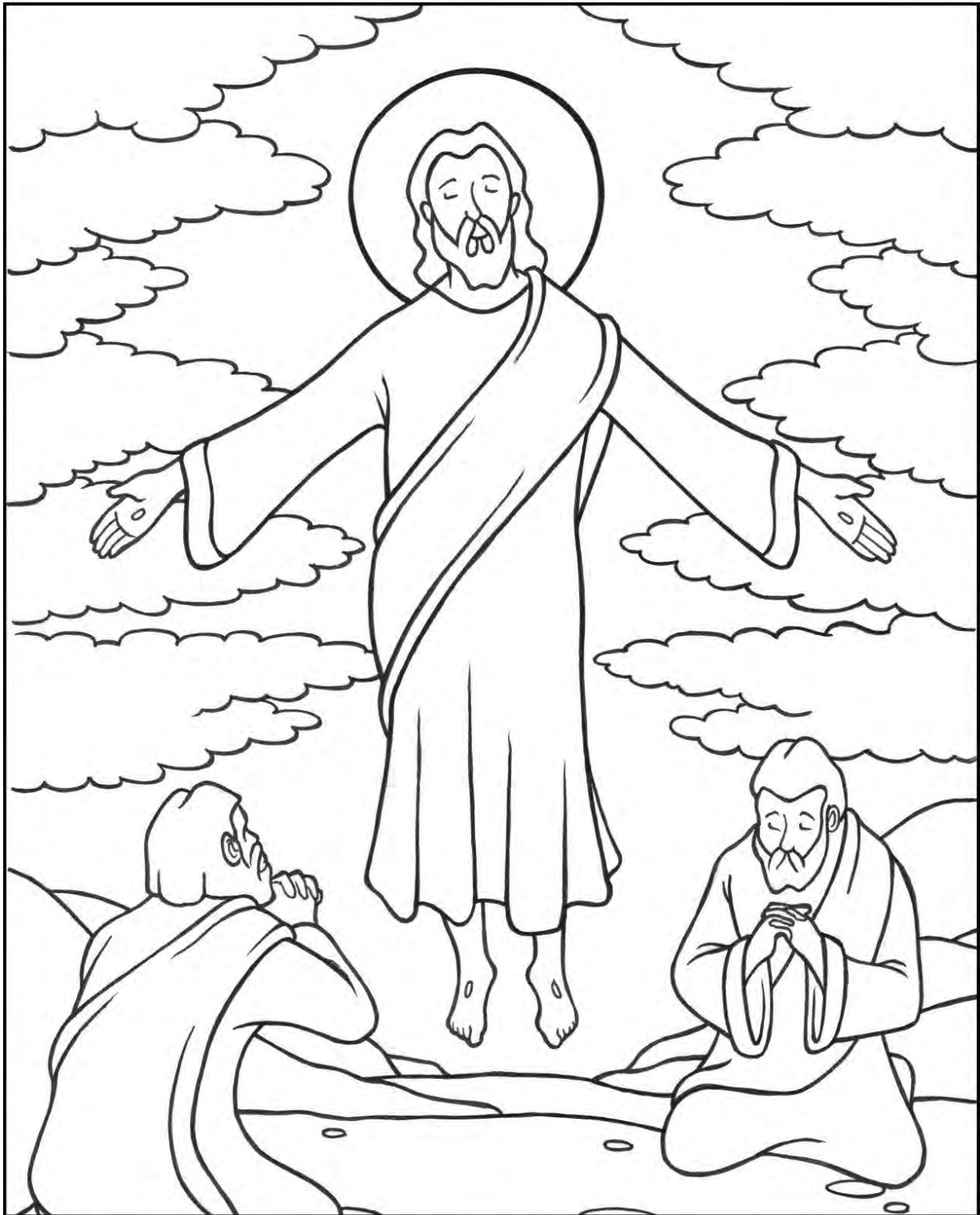
