## *A Message from the Pastor*

Dear Friends in Christ,

Last weekend, after a joyful celebration of Pentecost which included the Confirmation of three adults by Bishop Murphy, that joy was shattered by the tragic news of a brutal shooting in Owo, Nigeria. Catholics were attending Mass at St. Francis Xavier Parish when Islamic extremist stormed the church and began killing and maiming parishioners. Over fifty people were murdered and dozens more injured. Sadly, this senseless persecution of Christians – especially Catholics – is not rare. Nigeria is one of the most dangerous countries for Christians to live amid constant threat of danger. Only on occasion do most people hear about such atrocities. Perhaps many think of Christian oppression as something of centuries past, but that is hardly the case. Last weekend's horror demonstrates that far too vividly.

As we celebrate Trinity Sunday this weekend, it is a moment for us to remember what united all Christians amid our regrettable divisions – the belief in the one, true God revealed as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The unity of the Trinity is meant to be reflected in the unity of all Christ's disciples exemplified in their concern for each other. May we be instruments of God's peace in our communities and remain steadfast in our solidarity with those who suffer for the name Christian.

Sovereign God,  
we worship You and we acknowledge that You know all of those  
who suffer in Your name.

We remember those who are imprisoned for their faith and ask that they would join with the Apostle Paul to see that even though they remain captive,  
their chains have furthered the gospel, not frustrated it.  
May they inspire and embolden their fellow believers  
to speak the word of God more courageously and fearlessly.

God of all comfort,  
for those who are tortured both in body and mind, give them the grace to endure  
and to see their suffering as part of following in Christ's footsteps.


Merciful God,

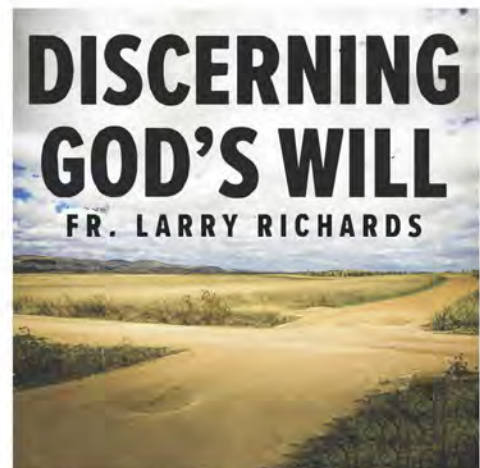

# Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

**June 19, 2022**

## **The Solemnity of the Most Holy Blood and Body of Christ**

**Lk 9:11b-17**

Jesus spoke to the crowds about the kingdom of God, and he healed those who needed to be cured. As the day was drawing to a close, the Twelve approached him and said, "Dismiss the crowd so that they can go to the surrounding villages and farms and find lodging and provisions; for we are in a deserted place here." He said to them, "Give them some food yourselves." They replied, "Five loaves and two fish are all we have, unless we ourselves go and buy food for all these people." Now the men there numbered about five thousand. Then he said to his disciples, "Have them sit down in groups of about fifty." They did so and made them all sit down. Then taking the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, he said the blessing over them, broke them, and gave them to the disciples to set before the crowd. They all ate and were satisfied. And when the leftover fragments were picked up, they filled twelve wicker baskets.

### Reflection Questions

- What did the disciples want to do with the large hungry crowd? What does Jesus tell the disciples to do?
- Jesus took five loaves of bread and two fish and was able to feed the entire crowd of 5,000 people until they were satisfied. What do we learn about Jesus from this story?
- What kinds of hungers do people have in addition to physical hunger? Think about the hungers that you and your family nourish. This week give thanks for the food that Jesus gives you in the Eucharist.

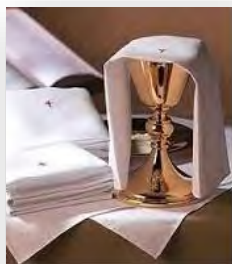
### **The Altar Linen Ministry is looking for volunteers!**
