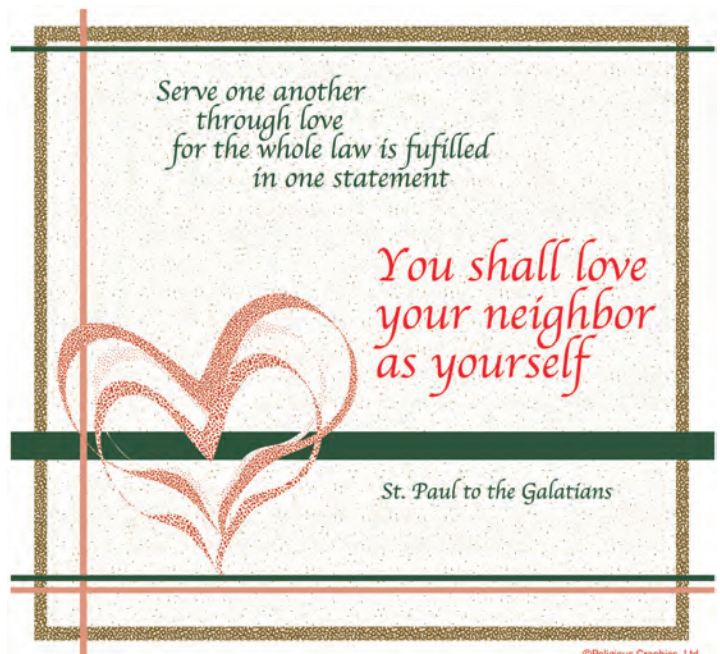

A Message from the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters of St. Gerard's,

This Monday marks four years since my official appointment as Pastor of our parish. It's remarkable to think of all that we've experienced and accomplished together in that relatively short amount of time – a major capital campaign, a multi-faceted overhaul of our campus, a global pandemic, finally having a beautiful, permanent church, and the expansion of ministries and active involvement of parishioners. I am grateful for the generosity of so many who have helped to achieve these goals. While I often receive words of gratitude as the leader of the community, I am well aware that I am privileged to marshal the talents and abilities of the committed disciples that make up this parish.

On Wednesday, we begin a new chapter together as I will assume the Pastorate of Infant Jesus Parish while remaining Pastor here. Over the past six weeks, I have been meeting with the clergy and staff of both parishes to plan as smooth a transition as possible. Many have expressed their willingness to help in whatever way they can, and I am most appreciative. I think the one thing I'll need the most is people's patience. Yes, I will be busy running between both places, but I still intend to be present as much as possible to those who need assistance.

Over the next few weeks, you will be seeing different priests here for Mass. The reality is that this is not only a dual position for me, but also for all the other clergy of both parishes. I trust you will find the other priests to be wonderful, holy men filled with zeal for the Gospel. All of us will be rotating Masses here at St. Gerard's and the church and chapel at Infant Jesus. This will be an opportunity for us to hear different voices break open God's word and share the richness of our Catholic faith.

As I explained when I announced this additional responsibility I am undertaking, the hard truth is that it's largely the result of a decrease in the number of priests who are able to become pastors in our diocese. Thanks be to God, we had three extraordinary young men ordained to the Priesthood last Saturday. We need to remain committed to praying for and encouraging vocation to the Priesthood within our parishes. The Priesthood is the gateway to the Eucharist, the source and summit of our lives as Catholics. As a Eucharistic community, pray the Holy Spirit can move the hearts and minds of young men to embrace with joy and fervor the extraordinary vocation to serve the Church as ordained ministers.

I thank you for your continued support of me and my brother clergy. Please pray for me that I may have the heart of Christ the Good Shepherd in guiding our parishes. I am grateful beyond measure for the past four years with you and I look forward to all that the future holds.

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

July 3, 2022

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Lk 10:1-12

At that time the Lord appointed seventy-two others whom he sent ahead of him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit. He said to them, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest. Go on your way; behold, I am sending you like lambs among wolves. Carry no money bag, no sack, no sandals; and greet no one along the way. Into whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this household.' If a peaceful person lives there, your peace will rest on him; but if not, it will return to you. Stay in the same house and eat and drink what is offered to you, for the laborer deserves his payment. Do not move about from one house to another. Whatever town you enter and they welcome you, eat what is set before you, cure the sick in it and say to them, 'The kingdom of God is at hand for you.' Whatever town you enter and they do not receive you, go out into the streets and say, 'The dust of your town that clings to our feet, even that we shake off against you.' Yet know this: the kingdom of God is at hand. I tell you, it will be more tolerable for Sodom on that day than for that town." The seventy-two returned rejoicing, and said, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us because of your name." Jesus said, "I have observed Satan fall like lightning from the sky. Behold, I have given you the power to 'tread upon serpents' and scorpions and upon the full force of the enemy and nothing will harm you. Nevertheless, do not rejoice because the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice because your names are written in heaven."

Reflection Questions

- How did Jesus send his disciples out? What would be some reasons for this approach? What does he call these who are sent out?
- Why does Jesus tell them to eat what is set before them? What kind of cities were the 70 sent to? What was the focus of their message?
- Why do people respond differently to the Gospel? What is one indication that God is working on a person's heart? Pray that you might be sensitive to those who are open to the Gospel.
