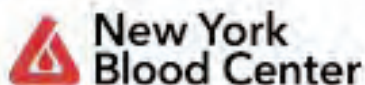

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

September 4, 2022

**Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time
Lk 14:25-33**

Great crowds were traveling with Jesus, and he turned and addressed them, "If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple. Which of you wishing to construct a tower does not first sit down and calculate the cost to see if there is enough for its completion? Otherwise, after laying the foundation and finding himself unable to finish the work the onlookers should laugh at him and say, 'This one began to build but did not have the resources to finish.' Or what king marching into battle would not first sit down and decide whether with ten thousand troops he can successfully oppose another king advancing upon him with twenty thousand troops? But if not, while he is still far away, he will send a delegation to ask for peace terms. In the same way, anyone of you who does not renounce all his possessions cannot be my disciple."

Reflection Questions

- Jesus outlines conditions under which people "cannot be my disciple." What are these conditions? What do these conditions have in common?
- In our culture, what does it mean to be a "follower"? How can those ideas end up shaping what we think it means to be a follower of Jesus?
- What do these conditions have to do with the examples Jesus gives?
- What do these conditions have to do with you? What is your response to these sayings of Jesus? Why?
