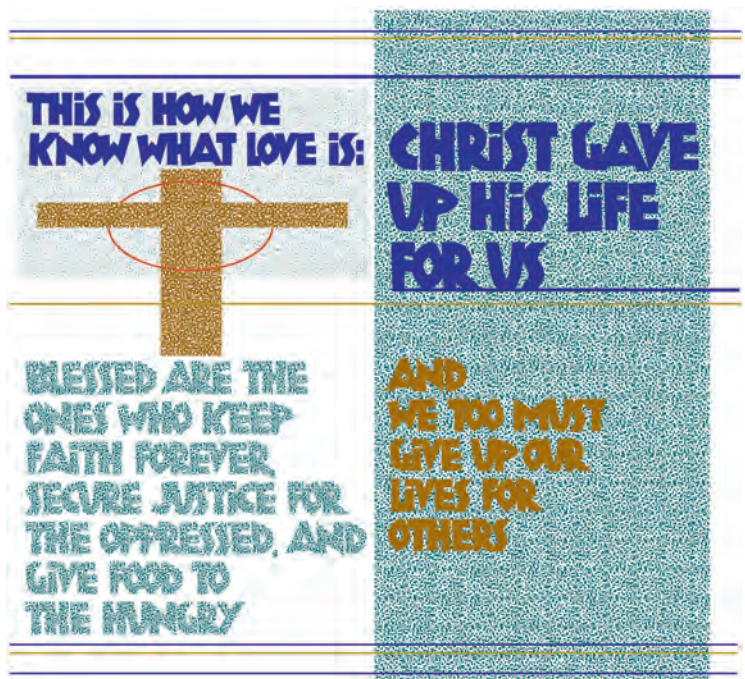

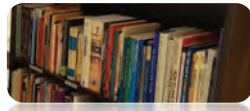

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

October 2, 2022

Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

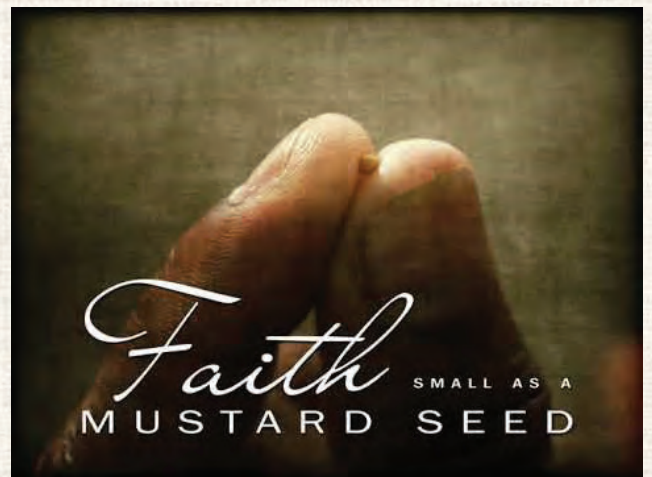
Lk 17:5-10

The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith." The Lord replied, "If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you.

"Who among you would say to your servant who has just come in from plowing or tending sheep in the field, 'Come here immediately and take your place at table'? Would he not rather say to him, 'Prepare something for me to eat. Put on your apron and wait on me while I eat and drink. You may eat and drink when I am finished'? Is he grateful to that servant because he did what was commanded? So should it be with you. When you have done all you have been commanded, say, 'We are unprofitable servants; we have done what we were obliged to do.'"

Reflection Questions

- Why do you think the apostles needed more faith? What was Jesus' response? Did the disciples need more faith? Or did they need a different kind of faith?
- Have you ever met someone who was really forgiving? What were they like? What was their faith like?
- Faith is placing your trust in someone or something. What is the object of true faith? Pray that the Lord would renew your faith in Him and ask Him to show you how you might walk in that faith this week.

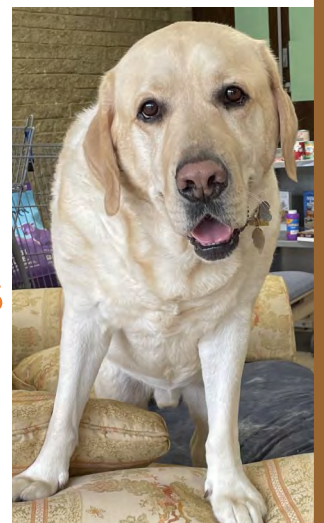

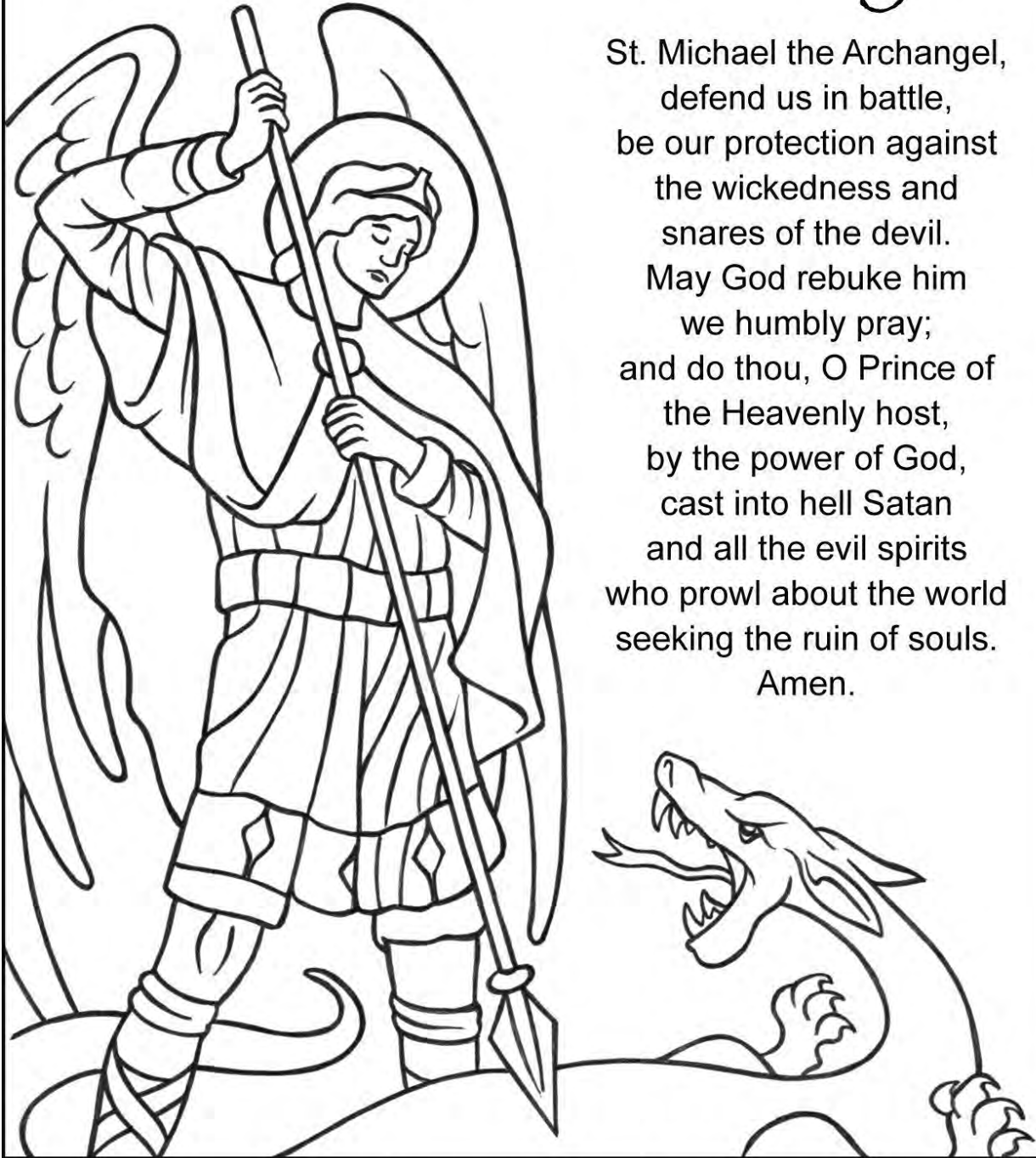

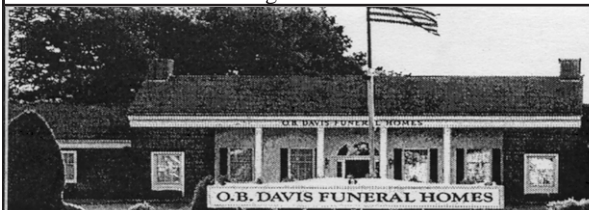
