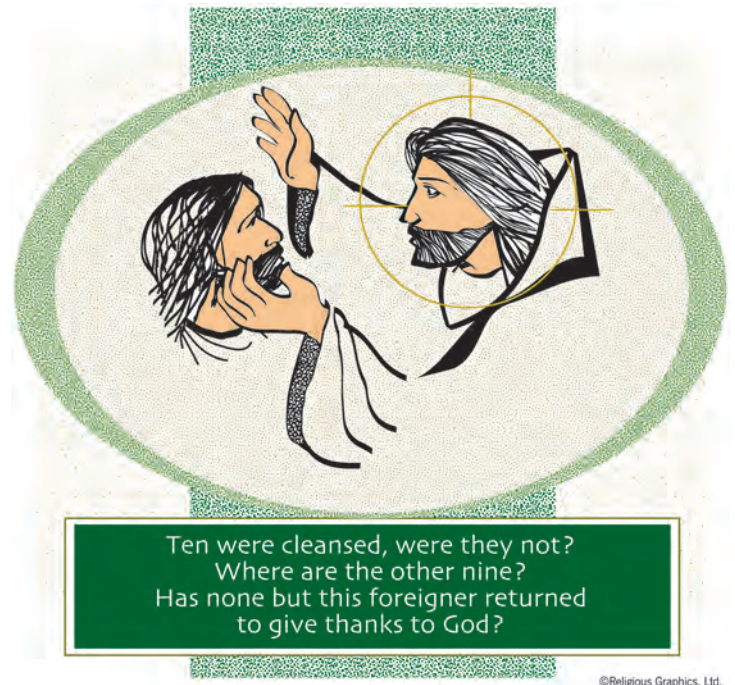

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

October 16, 2022

Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Lk 18:1-8

Jesus told his disciples a parable about the necessity for them to pray always without becoming weary. He said, "There was a judge in a certain town who neither feared God nor respected any human being. And a widow in that town used to come to him and say, 'Render a just decision for me against my adversary.' For a long time the judge was unwilling, but eventually he thought, 'While it is true that I neither fear God nor respect any human being, because this widow keeps bothering me I shall deliver a just decision for her lest she finally come and strike me.'" The Lord said, "Pay attention to what the dishonest judge says. Will not God then secure the rights of his chosen ones who call out to him day and night? Will he be slow to answer them? I tell you, he will see to it that justice is done for them speedily. But when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?"

Reflection Questions

- The narrator introduces the parable as being about "the need to pray always and never lose heart." Does this teaching seem more applicable to some situations than others? Which ones? Why? Are there situations that this teaching does not apply to? Which ones? Why?
- Have you ever been in the position of the judge? When? What did you do? Have you ever been in the position of the widow? When? What did you do? What insight into the story have these experiences given you?
- Does the widow demonstrate "faith"? How? Does the judge demonstrate "faith"? How? What does the parable tell us about "faith"?
