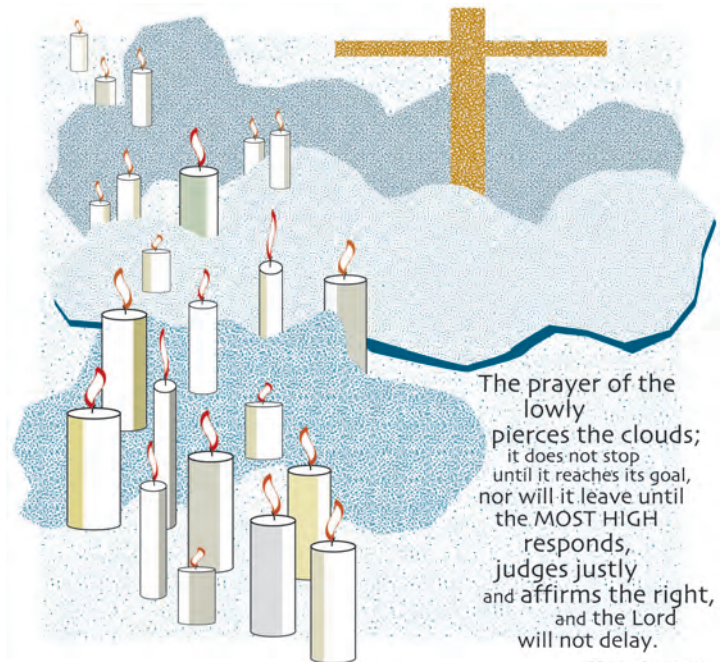

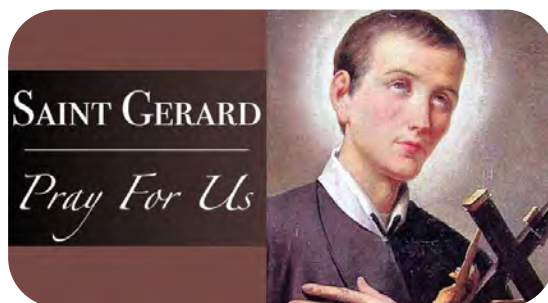

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

October 23, 2022

Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Lk 18:9-14

Jesus addressed this parable to those who were convinced of their own righteousness and despised everyone else.

"Two people went up to the temple area to pray; one was a Pharisee and the other was a tax collector. The Pharisee took up his position and spoke this prayer to himself, 'O God, I thank you that I am not like the rest of humanity -- greedy, dishonest, adulterous -- or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week, and I pay tithes on my whole income.' But the tax collector stood off at a distance and would not even raise his eyes to heaven but beat his breast and prayed, 'O God, be merciful to me a sinner.' I tell you, the latter went home justified, not the former; for whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted."

Reflection Questions

- There are two problems with the kind of people Jesus is addressing. What are they?
- How were the Pharisee and the tax collector regarded at that time in history? Which party was more loved or hated by society? Why?
- Is there any area of common agreement between the Pharisee and the tax collector? How may we apply this answer to all peoples all over the world?
- In your thanksgiving to God, how can you overcome the problem with the prayer of the Pharisee?

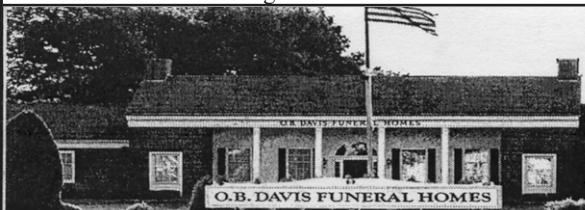
