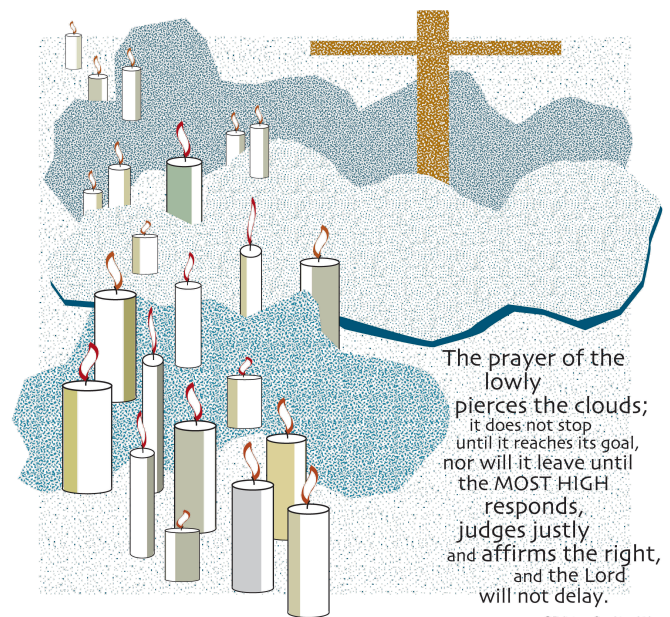

A Message from the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters of St. Gerard's,

This weekend, I will be installed formally as Pastor of Infant Jesus Parish. Humbled by this trust placed in me to shepherd a second parish, I am keenly aware of the many who, because of their cooperation and assistance, have made this possible. Both parishes are indeed blessed to have dedicated clergy and energetic staffs.

Last weekend saw two wonderful celebrations! The first was marked by our patronal feast of St. Gerard Majella. It was a joy to see so many people at Mass, especially at noon, which was followed by individual blessings. As in past years, a good number of people from outside our parish came to ask the intercession of St. Gerard for their personal intentions. You may have noticed the display in our lobby of just some of the many testimonials we have received over the years from people who experienced tremendous graces because of St. Gerard's intercession – families challenged either conceiving children or mothers who were in pregnancies risky both for them and their children. Still others have stories of physical, spiritual, and emotional healings attributed to our beloved Gerard.

In the second celebration, also last Sunday but at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel in Patchogue, catechists from around our diocese gathered to honor those who have reached milestones in ministry. Our own Director of Religious Education, Patty Longo, received an award for 20 years of distinguished service. Three of our catechists were also recognized – Dolores Stiles for 35 years, and Patricia Daniels and Victoria McGinn, both for 20 years. They serve alongside many other dedicated parishioners here who give generously of their time each week to help form our young people in the Catholic Faith. We are indebted to the zeal they bring to this most important work of our parish.

As I continue my ministry shepherding two parishes, I am consistently impressed with the amazing work happening all around our community, animated by the Holy Spirit and following in the apostolic mandate of Jesus. Yet, like the tax collector in today's Gospel, we may be standing off on the sidelines and, admitting our sinfulness, are reluctant to believe we can make a difference. But what justified that penitent sinner was his ability to recognize, even if imperfectly, God's willingness to forgive. Experiencing that grace enables us not only to be healed ourselves, but then to take up the mission of bringing that healing to others through evangelization. It is through our Baptism that we are each called to bring the Gospel to every situation and to allow its light to shine brightly in an otherwise dim world.

May God continue to do great things in, with and through us! Be assured of my prayers each day for you and your intentions. Please keep me in yours.





Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

October 30, 2022

Thirty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time

Lk 19:1-10

At that time, Jesus came to Jericho and intended to pass through the town. Now a man there named Zacchaeus, who was a chief tax collector and also a wealthy man, was seeking to see who Jesus was; but he could not see him because of the crowd, for he was short in stature. So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore tree in order to see Jesus, who was about to pass that way. When he reached the place, Jesus looked up and said, "Zacchaeus, come down quickly, for today I must stay at your house." And he came down quickly and received him with joy. When they all saw this, they began to grumble, saying, "He has gone to stay at the house of a sinner." But Zacchaeus stood there and said to the Lord, "Behold, half of my possessions, Lord, I shall give to the poor, and if I have extorted anything from anyone I shall repay it four times over." And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house because this man too is a descendant of Abraham. For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save what was lost."

Reflection Questions

- Zacchaeus is a "chief tax collector," "rich," "trying to see who Jesus was," and "short of stature." Based on these descriptions, what do you feel you know about Zacchaeus? Why?
- What do you see as Zacchaeus' positive or sympathetic features or qualities? Why? What do you see as his negative or less positive features? Why?
- Are there any ways Zacchaeus seems similar to you? What are they? Why? Any ways Zacchaeus seems different from you? Again, what are they? Why? How do you feel about this?

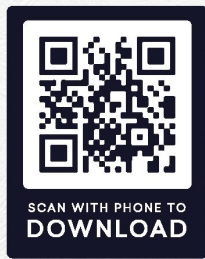

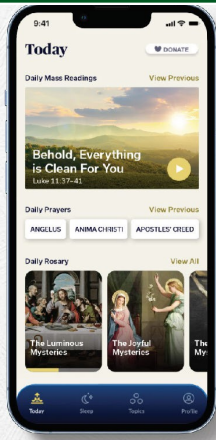
All Souls Day Novena

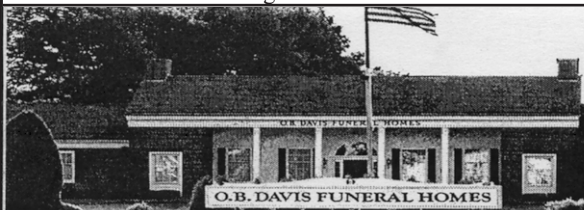
