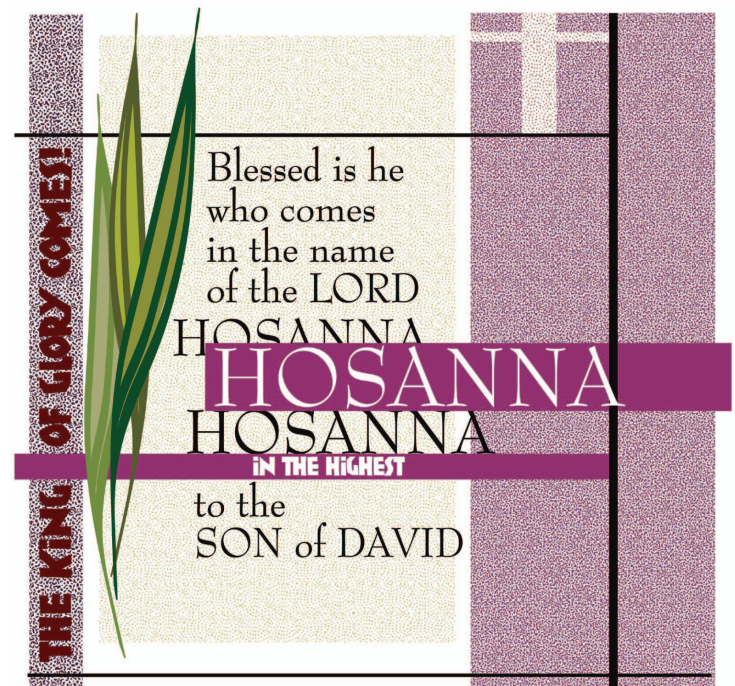

## A Message from the Pastor



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

*"Hosanna to Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!"*

Having begun this sacred time of Holy Week, we make our own the anthem of the crowds that welcomed Jesus as he entered Jerusalem, the City of David, to complete His saving mission. Each day this week, the scripture passages at Mass chronicle the events that lead Jesus to the cross, and to the tomb. Then we wait

For well over a decade, our region has marked **Monday of Holy Week** as a day dedicated to the Sacrament of Confession. Every Catholic parish in the Archdiocese of New York and in the Dioceses of Brooklyn and Rockville Centre will make the sacrament available from 2-4pm and 6-9pm. No matter how long it has been since you last visited the confessional, I urge you to take advantage of this opportunity to receive the *mercy, forgiveness, and fresh start* afforded by God's grace.

On **Tuesday of Holy Week**, the priests of our diocese will gather with Bishop Barres and hundreds of laity at our St. Agnes Cathedral for the Chrism Mass. During this liturgy, the Bishop will consecrate the holy oils used throughout the year. Also, we priests will renew the promises we made on the day of our ordination. You can watch the Chrism Mass via our diocesan television network, Catholic Faith Network, or via their website, catholicfaithnetwork.org. Please pray, not only for an increase of vocations to the priesthood, but for a deepening holiness among us priests who are called to be ministers of God's sacramental grace to His People.

Holy Thursday begins the most sacred of all days – the Paschal Triduum, from the Latin for *three days*. The **Mass of the Lord's Supper** will be celebrated in the evening. We recall how Jesus used the Passover seder meal to institute both the Eucharist and the Priesthood. The *mandatum* – or Jesus' command to serve – is exemplified by the washing of feet. After a brief procession, the assembly has the opportunity to spend time before the Blessed Sacrament – a special time of prayer and gratitude for the gift of the Eucharist.

Good Friday's principal event is the **Solemn Liturgy of the Lord's Passion at 3:00pm**. It is the only day of the year when Mass is not celebrated. Rather, after the reading of solemn intercessions and the veneration of the cross, the assembly receives Holy Communion that was consecrated the evening before. There are also Stations of the Cross – which might be more conducive to families with little ones – at 12:00pm and at 7:00pm.

Finally, Easter commences with the **Solemn Vigil at 8:00pm** on Holy Saturday evening. Throughout the world, Catholics gather to welcome new members of the Church through the sacraments of initiation and to renew their own baptismal commitment. Easter Sunday Masses break the gloom of Lenten penance with the joyful return to singing, "Alleluia!"

Please be sure to look in the bulletin at the schedule of liturgies for Holy Week. They're also on our parish website. Join us in celebrating these most sacred days of our faith, as we recall how God's love and mercy culminated in His only begotten Son offering Himself for all of humanity to end sin and death.

May you have a meaningful Holy Week!

## ***Palm Sunday Craft***

Supplies to make 2 Hosanna Branch Wavers:

Green construction paper- 4 sheets, 4-8 jumbo craft sticks, Clear tape, A pencil, Scissors, A glue-stick

Instructions:

1. Outline your child's hand on the green construction paper. (Make a minimum of 6 outlines. 8-10 will make your child's waver really wave!)

2. If your child is old enough to use a pair of scissors, allow him/her to cut around the handprint outlines.

Else leave this part to the adult supervising the craft.

3. Now stick the handprint outlines two on each row and build on upwards.

4. Finally tape two craft sticks to the bottom of the "branch" securely with the tape.

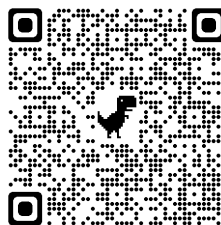

## *Breaking Open the Word*

**Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?**

**April 9, 2023**

### **The Resurrection of the Lord**

**Jn 20:1-9**

On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb. So she ran and went to Simon Peter and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and told them, "They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they put him." So Peter and the other disciple went out and came to the tomb. They both ran, but the other disciple ran faster than Peter and arrived at the tomb first; he bent down and saw the burial cloths there, but did not go in. When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.

### **Reflection Questions**

- What did Mary Magdalene discover when she went to Jesus' tomb?
- How did Peter respond to what Mary told him? How did John respond to what he found in the tomb?
- If you had been either Mary, Peter, or John, what thoughts would have run through your mind when you discovered the empty tomb?
- What motivates us to share our surprises (both pleasant and unpleasant) with other people?
- Whom do you need to tell about the empty tomb of Christ? How?

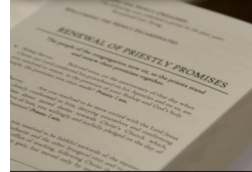

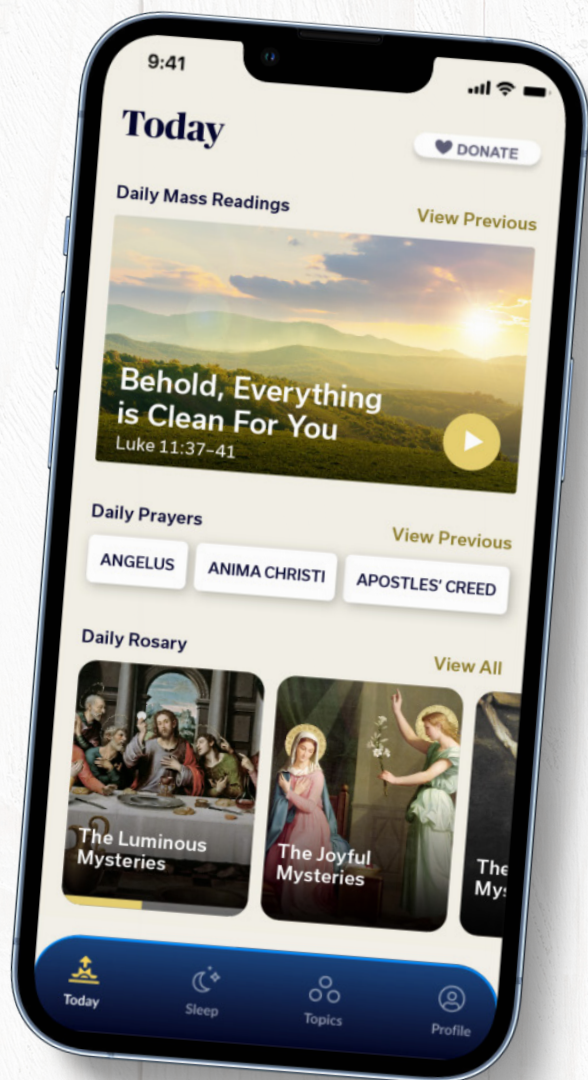
## *Divine Mercy Sunday*
