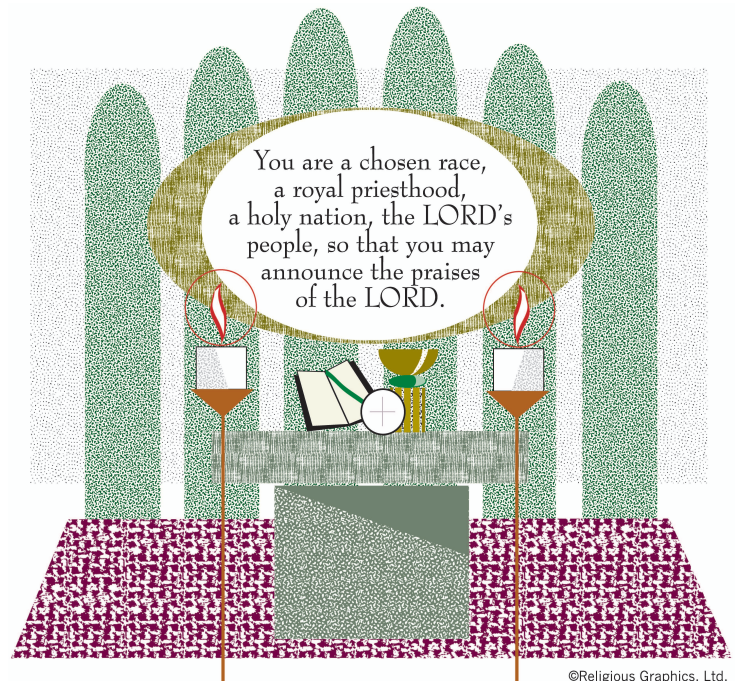

A Message from the Pastor



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

May is that month each year when we honor our Blessed Mother – and indeed all mothers – in a particular way. Appropriately, we began this month last Monday by celebrating the minor feast of St. Joseph, the spouse of the Blessed Mother, under the title “The Worker.” In some countries, May 1st is their version of our Labor Day as it celebrates the immeasurable contribution their citizens make by offering their daily work – in whatever form it takes – for the glory of God and the sanctification of the world. So, this month is also a reminder to us of the humble beginnings of the Holy Family, who knew what it was like to live simply and quietly, yet whose work would usher in the salvation of the world. Our lives can sometimes seem ordinary, or even mundane, yet it is precisely in offering our work as a labor of love that it can sanctify – make holy – be a task that honors God and works towards some greater good. Every time we wash another dish, fold another load of laundry, help a child with a small task or assist someone in need, we can offer that labor to build up the Kingdom of God in our midst.

May can be a wonderful time to reconnect with our Blessed Mother. During this Easter season, we are reminded of how Our Lady remained by her Son faithfully through his betrayal, suffering, and death on the Cross; how she was also allowed to behold the glory of the Resurrection. In short, like us, Mary experienced the terrible sorrows and incredible joys of life. She understands our hearts and lives remarkably well and is therefore an indispensable advocate for us each and every day. If you haven’t already, take time to draw closer to Mary through the simple prayer of the Rosary. This prayer is one that has changed countless lives throughout the centuries.

Finally, this month is marked also by the reception of the Easter sacraments, especially First Holy Communions. Please keep the many children in our parish, as well as their families, in your prayer during these weeks. While sad to acknowledge, the truth is that fewer and fewer families are making the Eucharist central to their weekly schedules, and even more have lost belief in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in Holy Communion. Now is a wonderful time to re-enliven our faith and deepen our realization of all that God wishes to give us in this “bread of angels” we are privileged to receive at every Mass. In a few weeks, our entire country will be invited to a Eucharistic Revival, a time of reaching out to those who have fallen away from the practice of the faith. In doing so, we can enjoy the grace of our own faith being increased in this most holy gift of God.

May all that we say and do, after the example of the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Joseph, be for God’s glory and the building up of God’s Kingdom.

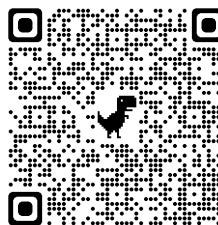

May 14, 2023

Sixth Sunday of Easter

Jn 14:15-21

Jesus said to his disciples:
"If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot accept, because it neither sees nor knows him. But you know him, because he remains with you, and will be in you. I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you. In a little while the world will no longer see me, but you will see me, because I live and you will live. On that day you will realize that I am in my Father and you are in me and I in you. Whoever has my commandments and observes them is the one who loves me. And whoever loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and reveal myself to him."

Reflection Questions

- Who is the Advocate?
- How do you think the disciples felt when they heard these words?
- How do you think the disciples will feel after they receive this gift of the Holy Spirit?
- What does Jesus say the Holy Spirit will do for the disciples?
- Jesus has also given us the gift of the Holy Spirit, whom we received at Baptism. If we call upon the Holy Spirit, he will help us understand God's love for us and will help us follow Jesus. Spend some time in prayer this week, asking for the Holy Spirit's guidance.

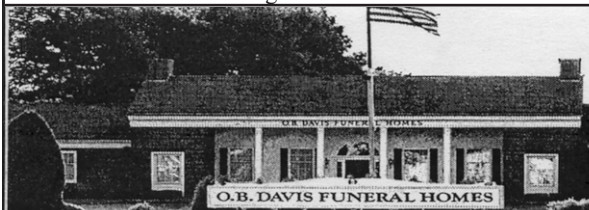
