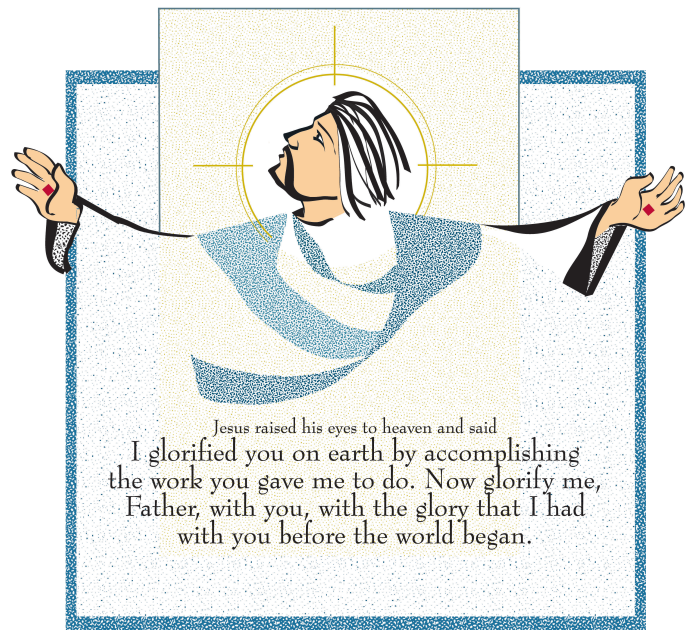

A Message from the Pastor



Dear Parishioners,

Having celebrated last Thursday the Solemnity of the Ascension of Our Lord, we are now in the midst of the Great Novena – those nine of days of more intense prayer awaiting the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. We're all probably familiar with the term 'novena.' There are many devotions to various saints which may include a novena of prayer. In essence, a novena is a way to concentrate on a particular intention or need, either for us or someone else, keeping in mind that prayer is always about opening one's heart to the transformative power of God's grace so that we can become more vibrant vessels of His grace. We must not confuse praying novenas with magic, as can sometimes happen. An example is the Novena to St. Jude. It is not necessary, or even appropriate, to leave copies of the prayer in a church or to forward it to numerous people, or any other such ambitious personal mission.

While this time right now between the Ascension and Pentecost is an ideal time, a novena can be made anytime throughout the year. The following is one among such prayers that can be used as part of a novena to the Holy Spirit:

*Holy Spirit, third Person of the Blessed Trinity, Spirit of Truth, Love and Holiness,
proceeding from the Father and the Son, and equal to Them in all things,
I adore You and love You with all my heart.*

*Dearest Holy Spirit, confident in Your deep, personal love for me, I am making this novena for the
following request, if it should be Your Holy Will to grant it (mention your request).*

*Teach me, Divine Spirit, to know and seek my last end; grant me the holy fear of God;
grant me true contrition and patience. Do not let me fall into sin.
Give me an increase of faith, hope, and charity,
and bring forth in my soul all the virtues proper to my state of life.*

*Make me a faithful disciple of Jesus and an obedient child of the Church.
Give me efficacious grace sufficient to keep the commandments
and to receive the sacraments worthily.
Give me the four Cardinal Virtues, Your Seven Gifts, Your Twelve Fruits.
Raise me to perfection in the state of life to which You have called me and lead me
through a happy death to everlasting life. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.*

Please keep in your prayers the members of our parish who will receive the sacrament of Confirmation this weekend. They have prepared diligently for this moment and opened their hearts to the power of the Holy Spirit. May they be ardent and faithful witnesses to the Gospel in word and deed.

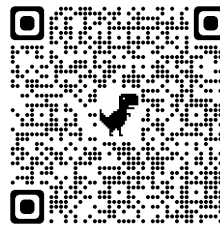

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

May 28, 2023

Pentecost Sunday

Jn 20:19-23

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained."

Reflection Questions

- The Feast of Pentecost celebrates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon Jesus' first disciples. This same Holy Spirit is still with us. After giving them the gift of the Holy Spirit, what does Jesus tell his disciples to do?
- Why might Jesus' greeting of peace have been so welcoming to his disciples?
- How does this passage treat the relationship between doubt and faith?
- Just as Jesus sent his disciples to forgive the sins of others, so too are we sent to bring peace to the world. And we also have been given the gift of the Holy Spirit to help us with this task. Ask the Holy Spirit this coming week to help you to forgive your loved ones.

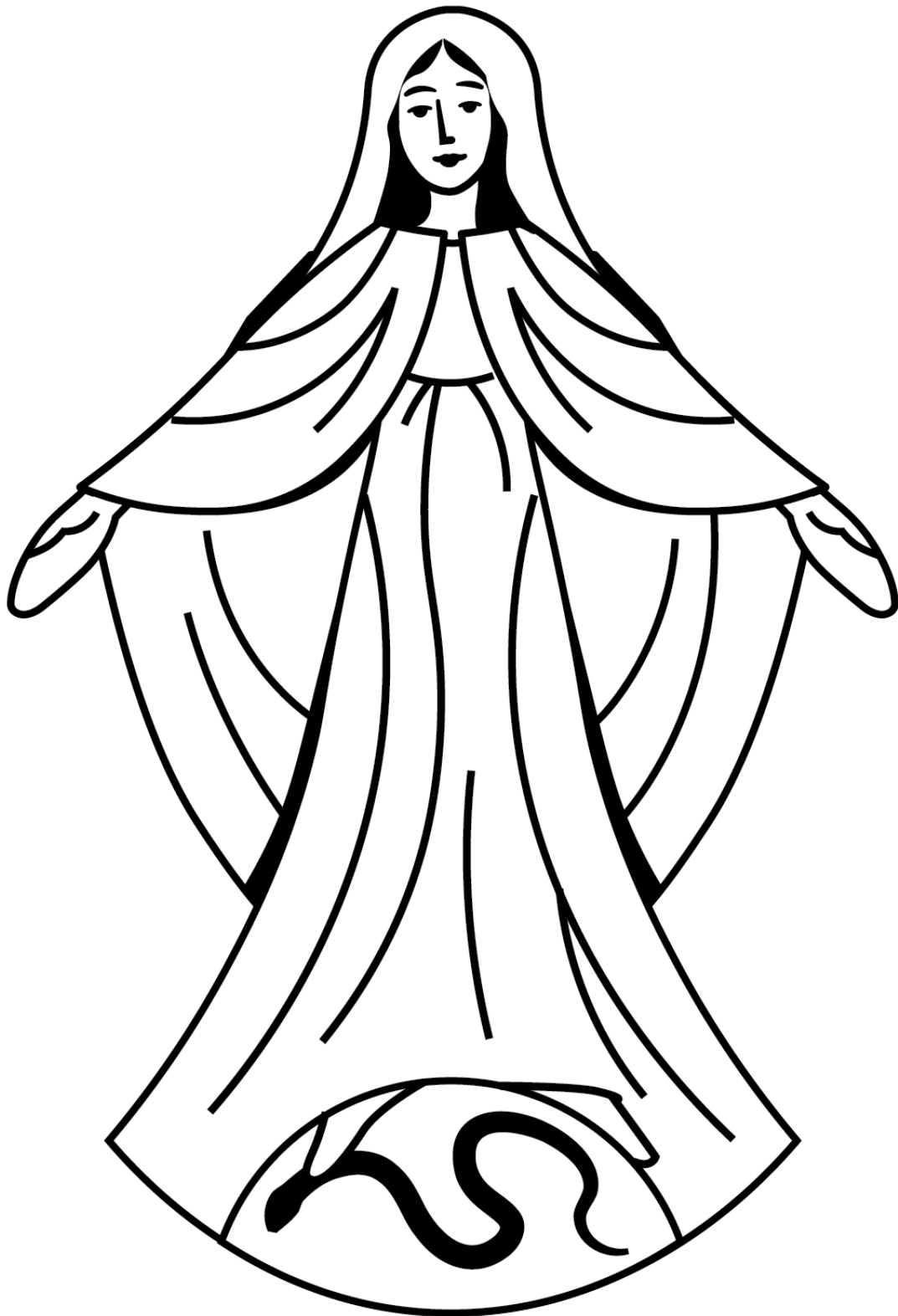

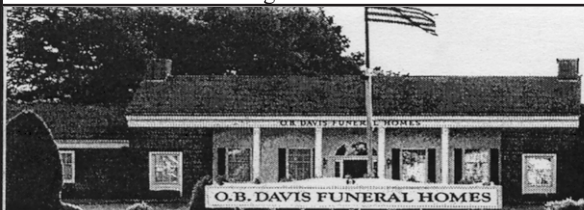
