## *A Message from the Pastor*



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, we have come to the close of the Easter season.

Our journey to this moment began just over three months ago when our foreheads were marked with ashes as a reminder of our mortality. Then commenced our annual Lenten season of deepened prayer, charity, and penance. We were challenged, as members of Christ's body, the Church, to open our minds and hearts to the power of God's grace in even more profound ways. Then, in the joy of the Resurrection, we celebrated the reality that Christ has conquered every power of this world, even death itself. We now have the assured means of everlasting life – life in Christ Jesus! Over the past few Sundays, we have unpacked the power of the Resurrection by hearing largely from St. John's Gospel, where Jesus has been speaking about the Advocate, the Paraclete Who will come to His followers. And today, we commemorate that incredible moment in the Upper Room when the Apostles, accompanied by the Blessed Mother of Our Lord, were filled with the Holy Spirit, Who empowered them to proclaim boldly the Good News of Jesus Christ.

In our parish this weekend, several of our brothers and sisters will receive the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist for the first time. In witnessing their desire to become fully initiated into the Church, it is also a time for us to renew our commitment to living out the promises of own Baptism, sealed in the gift of Confirmation, and nourished by the Eucharist. Like the Apostles, we are commissioned to be witnesses to our Lord in the way we live our lives, in word and deed. We have that capacity within us to transform hearts and minds as Jesus did, because we have the Holy Spirit dwelling within us. We must never underestimate our ability to do something amazing for God's glory and to come to the aid of someone in need. Indeed, that is precisely the point of our having received such rich gifts in the sacraments of the Church – to share those graces with others and thereby draw them closer to the One Who desires to be Lord of their lives.

*Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful  
and kindle in them the fire of your love.*

*Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created,  
and you shall renew the face of the earth.*

*Let us pray.*

*O God, who has taught the hearts of the faithful  
by the light of the Holy Spirit,  
grant that in the same Spirit we may be truly wise  
and ever rejoice in his consolation.  
Through Christ our Lord. Amen.*

## *Praying with the Holy Spirit*

The language of prayer is mystery, the mystery of the encounter between the human soul and its Creator, the invisible God. Indeed, we scarcely need St. Paul to remind us that “we do not know how to pray as we ought” (Romans 8:26). So many of the circumstances of our lives can defy our poor power to respond in prayer. How do we sing of God’s goodness? How do we lament our deepest sorrows? How do we extoll God’s glory? What is the language that can express our love of God and our reception of God’s love for us?

The Holy Spirit can speak for us through the Scriptures. The Word of God is alive, because it was written under the inspiration of the Spirit. When we take those words upon our own lips, the Spirit speaks anew through us. Many traditional hymns and contemporary worship songs take their lyrics directly from the Scriptures too. Whether we speak or sing biblical texts, we can offer back to the Father, by the Spirit, God’s own perfect words.

Sometimes our prayer is beyond being captured by any words. This is when the prayer of our hearts can be made by the Spirit in language beyond our understanding, “with sighs too deep for words” (Romans 8:26). Try the following exercise that can help us to trust the Holy Spirit to pray in and through us.

### ***Prayer Exercise***

Come into a space of quiet. Become present to our ever-present God. Invite God to be with you.

Become aware of your breath. The very act of breathing is an expression of the presence of God, who sustains our lives in this moment and every moment. Remember, in Hebrew, Spirit and breath are the same word, ruah.

At our Baptism and Confirmation, God sends his Spirit to reside in us. As you sit in the quiet, notice how you experience the Spirit residing in you. Where in your body do you come to know the active presence of God? In your heart? Your mind? Your gut? Be aware of this truth: God lives in you by the Spirit, here, now.

Continue for as long as you feel called to be in the stillness, aware that God is with you. What might the Spirit be praying in and through you? Set words completely aside. Listen.

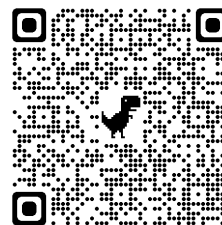

### **Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity**

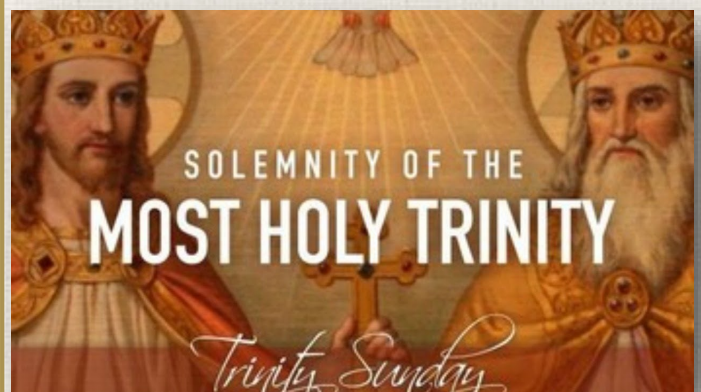
**Jn 3:16-18**

God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.

For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him will not be condemned, but whoever does not believe has already been condemned, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.

### **Reflection Questions**

- In what way did God demonstrate his love for rebellious sinners according to John 3:16? What does it say about the depth and breadth of sin in our lives that someone had to die? What does it say about the depth and breadth of God's love that he was willing to sacrifice his only Son and that Jesus was willing to die on our behalf?
- In what manner did God love the world?
- What does "everlasting life" mean? Who has "everlasting life"?
- Are there sins in your life, for which is keeping you away from Jesus?
- What is meant by Jesus being God the Father's "only" Son?

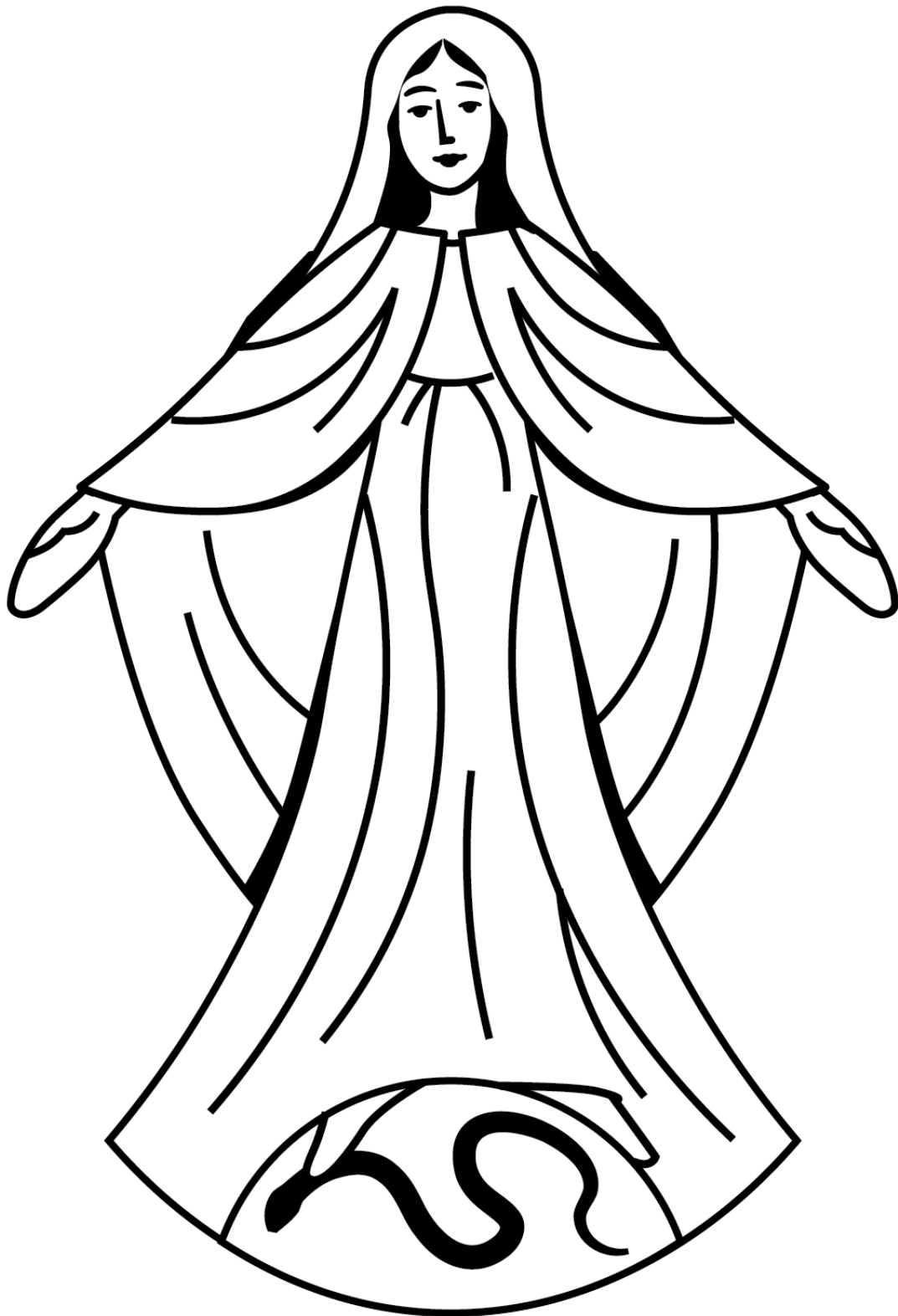

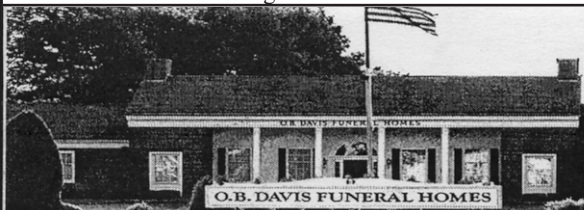
