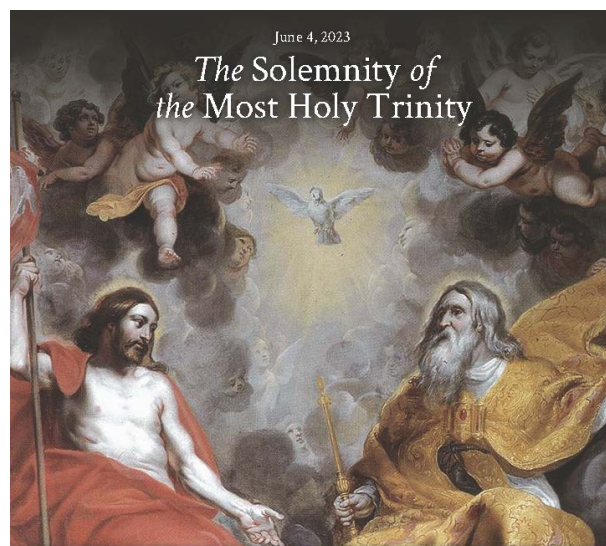

A Message from the Pastor



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Allow me to bring three important items to your attention this weekend. First, having returned to Ordinary Time, the Church offers the annual commemoration of the Most Holy Trinity this weekend and the great feast of *Corpus Christi* or the Body and Blood of Christ next Sunday. These two feasts complete a sort of triffecta after Pentecost and help us to refocus on two fundamental realities of our faith: the revelation of the Trinity and the gift of the Eucharist. This year, the feast of *Corpus Christi* will inaugurate a year of Eucharistic revival in our diocese and throughout the country. Sadly, recent polls tell us that fewer and fewer Catholics are participating at Mass. I think we can all agree when we look back to years ago, there has been a steady decline in attendance at Mass. Even more seriously is the decreasing number of Catholics who say they believe in the real Presence of Christ in the consecrated Eucharist. The Bishops of America have begun an enthusiastic program of teaching and revitalization about the Eucharist, and we will be part of that renewal. There will be several programs and times for prayer throughout the coming year to help us all gain a deeper appreciation for and love of the Eucharist – so stay tuned!

One way we're going to kick off this renewal is through a series of bulletin articles that will appear next week and continue into the summer. These reflections were penned by Deacon Frank Dell'Aglio and offer us scriptural references for the Eucharist. They will help us to understand God's design in giving us this most precious gift and explain the authentic Catholic teaching that the Eucharist is not a sign or symbol, but the actual Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Blessed Lord. Please be sure to read these articles over the next few weeks.

Finally, now that we have embarked (unofficially) into summer and find ourselves in June, we recall the particular devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Observed the Friday after Corpus Christi, this year the Feast of the Sacred Heart falls on June 16th. Please make an extra effort either to come to Mass on that day or to take some time during it to ask God to open your heart to His. You may wish to begin the novena below to the Sacred Heart this coming Wednesday, June 7th. The graces that flow from such a devotion are profound indeed.

O Lord Jesus Christ, to your most Sacred Heart, I confide this/these intention:
(mention your intention)

Only look upon me, and then do What your Sacred Heart inspires.

Let your Sacred Heart decide I count on it, I trust in it I throw myself on Your mercy,
Lord Jesus! You will not fail me.

Sacred Heart of Jesus, I trust in You. Sacred Heart of Jesus, I believe in Your love for me. Sacred Heart of
Jesus, Your Kingdom come. O Sacred Heart of Jesus,

I have asked you for many favors, But I earnestly implore this one. Take it.

covered with Your Precious Blood, He will not refuse it.

It will be no longer my prayer, But Yours, O Jesus.

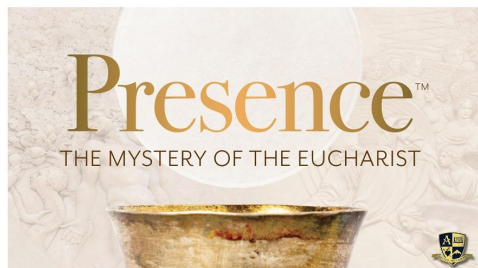
O Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in You.

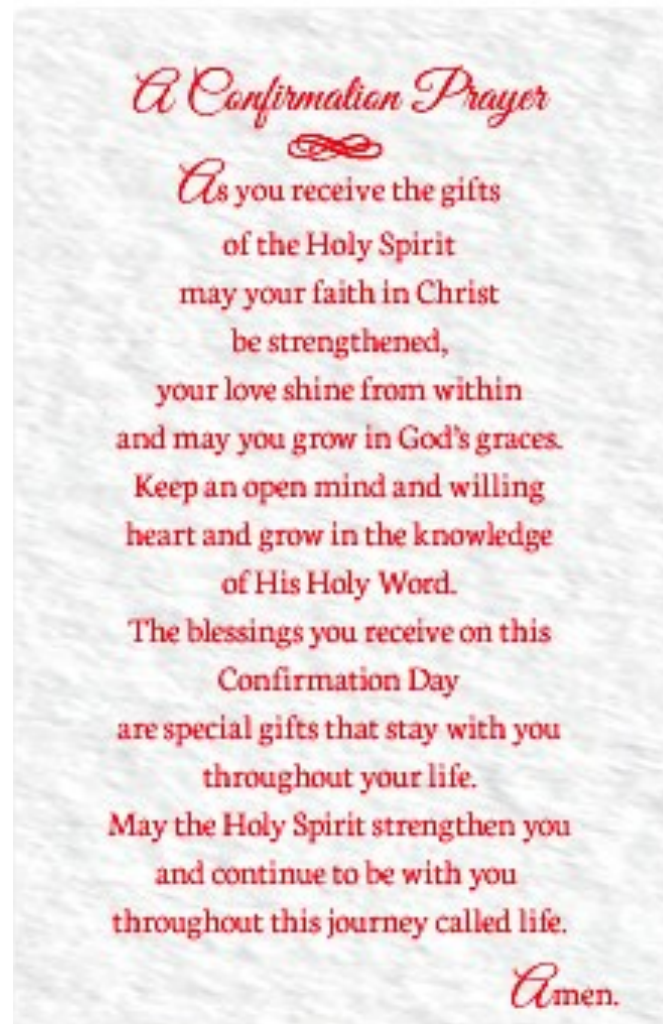

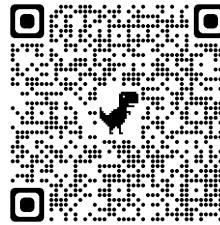

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

June 11, 2023

Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ

Jn 6:51-58

Jesus said to the Jewish crowds:
"I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."

The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever."

Reflection Questions

- When Jesus gives us himself in the Eucharist, does he give us his presence, or does he give us himself in the action of the whole Paschal Mystery (passion, death, resurrection)?
- What is different about the food God gave the people in the desert and the food he gives us? "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him."
- In the Eucharist, the bread and the wine become the Body and Blood of Christ. When we share in the Eucharist, Jesus is present to us, and through our communion we will share eternal life. What does it mean for you to receive Jesus in the Eucharist?

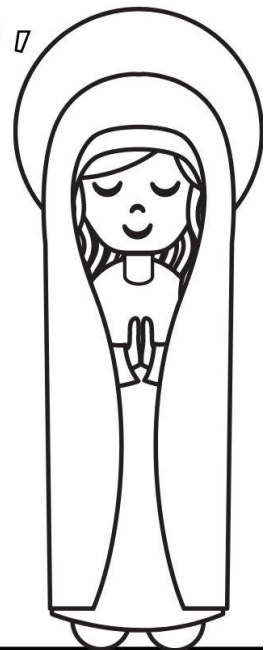
