## **True Presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament**

As we look ahead to the next proof, we remember the manna from heaven which sustained three million Israelites for forty years. God fed His people daily!

In the prayer that Jesus taught His disciples, He prays “give us this day our daily bread.” Have you ever wondered why Jesus made a double reference to the day when He said, “give us this day our daily bread”? Why didn't He say *give us this day our bread* or *give us our daily bread*? The FOURTH PROOF relates to that prayer that Jesus taught us, commonly referred to as the “Our Father.” The original known texts of Matthew and Luke's Gospels were written in the Greek language. The words, day and daily in this Greek text, are “hemera” (day) and “epiousios” (daily).

The word “hemera” can be found in Greek literature for at least a millennium before the time of Christ. However, the word “epiousios” does not exist in Greek literature before the time of Christ, or after, except in the Gospels of Matthew and Luke, and in written commentaries on these Gospel passages. Linguists refer to it as a neologism, or new word.

But look here. Something interesting happens when this word is broken into two, as it forms two Greek words, “epi” and “ousios.” And each of these Greek words can be found in Greek literature for hundreds of years before the time of Christ. The word “epi” means above or super in English, while the word “ousios” means substance or nature. Put together, we get above nature or super substance. This can also be said to mean super-natural. Now, let's replace daily with super-natural. “Give us this day our super-natural bread”!

You may ask when this meaning was discovered. The answer: as early as the third century. St Cyprian, St Cyril of Jerusalem, and St Jerome (all of whom are Fathers of the Church) all wrote biblical commentaries on these passages, and they drew the same conclusion which I have outlined here for you. St Jerome is particularly noteworthy, as he is the person who translated the bible into one common language, Latin. That fourth century translation of the bible is referred to as the Latin Vulgate. In it he writes these words translated from the Latin: “Give us this day our supersubstantial bread”!

**Jesus is teaching His disciples to pray each day to receive  
super-natural bread or what we would refer to today as the Blessed Sacrament!**

## *A Message from our Pastor*



Dear Brothers and Sisters of St. Gerard's,

We come to the end of June – believe it or not! – and I would like to share with you some personal thoughts about the prominence of the coming week. Tuesday, I will celebrate the fourteenth anniversary of my ordination to the priesthood. Even though I say it each year, it never fails to be true: being a priest is an amazing gift! I am so happy to have been called by God to serve the Church in this capacity. The encounters that I have had with people, the opportunities to study the richness of our Catholic Faith, and the privilege of serving as a Pastor are blessings beyond measure. At the end of the day a few weeks ago, I was catching up with friends over Facetime. They asked how my day was, and I succinctly ticked off the things I had done – morning Mass, a funeral, some desk work, a call to anoint someone, a counseling session, a talk to kids at religious education, and a wake service. They were stunned at the variety of my day. I just chuckled. I have become so used to the diversity that any day can bring.

Two weeks ago, our diocese celebrated the ordination of a young man, Father Steven McClernon. He will undoubtedly be a wonderful asset to any parish and ministry to which he is assigned. However, the truth is that we need about twenty more Father McClernons to meet the needs of the 1.5 million Catholics across Nassau and Suffolk Counties. My dual pastorate is evidence of that. We need to increase our prayer for and actively encourage young men to consider the priesthood. In our local culture, one that understandably pushes young people to pursue career paths that will bring them the American dream -- a house, family, ample income, two cars, and nice vacations -- the priesthood can seem to be a loss compared to that. But it most certainly is not! The joy that comes from laying down one's life in service of the Gospel is incomparable. Please encourage the young men you know to consider seriously, and prayerfully, if God might be calling them to be priests.

Tuesday marks another personal anniversary – five years as Pastor of St. Gerard's. When I think back on all that has happened in that time, it seems as though I've been here for decades. At the same time, those years have moved swiftly. I'm grateful for your support and the collaboration of my brother clergy, especially with my having assumed the pastorate of Infant Jesus last year. It certainly has been a challenging year but, through the hard work of so many, we're making it work. Please keep me in your prayers as you, your family, and intentions are in mine each day.

### The Miracle at *Every* Mass

Jesus makes a miracle happen at every Mass so he can be close to me. What can kids do at Mass? *So much!*

**1. GETTING READY**  
The Church is Jesus' house, and Jesus is my King. When I get ready for Mass, it's nice to dress up because it is so special to be in the King's house. I make sure I am clean and neat when I go to Mass. I especially make sure I brush my teeth!

**2. LISTENING**  
During the first part of the Mass, we read from the Bible. I ask God what he wants to tell me today, and listen to the stories. God likes to talk to us through his Word. Maybe he has a message for me!

**3. MY GIFT FOR JESUS**  
After the readings, we pass around a basket to collect gifts for the Church and the poor. Grown-ups usually give money, but Jesus wants something even more special from kids. I think of something I can offer Jesus in my heart and imagine my gift going up to the altar with the bread and wine. God is about to do something really amazing with our gifts.

**4. THE MIRACLE**  
When I hear Jesus' words, "This is my body," a miracle happens! God changes the bread and wine into the real Body and Blood of Jesus. The host still looks like bread, but Jesus is there in disguise.

**5. JESUS COMES INTO MY HEART**  
I fold my hands reverently in the Communion line. When I receive Jesus, I thank him for visiting me in this amazing way. While I wait for everyone else to receive communion, this is the perfect time to have a private conversation with Jesus in my heart.

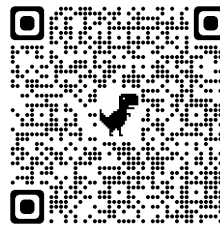

## Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

**July 2, 2023**

**Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**Mt 10:37-42**

Jesus said to his apostles:

"Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me. Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it.

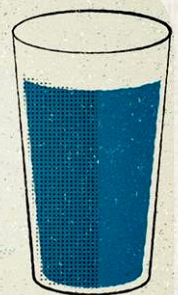
"Whoever receives you receives me, and whoever receives me receives the one who sent me. Whoever receives a prophet because he is a prophet will receive a prophet's reward, and whoever receives a righteous man because he is a righteous man will receive a righteous man's reward. And whoever gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones to drink because the little one is a disciple—amen, I say to you, he will surely not lose his reward."

### Reflection Questions

- What does it mean to say that one has come to a crossroads?
- Jesus says some difficult things at the beginning of this Gospel. What does Jesus say?
- This Gospel reminds us that when we choose to follow Jesus, we might face some crossroads—times when we must part company with others, perhaps because these others are doing things that are not right. Instead we must choose to act in ways that show that we are disciples of Jesus. How can you act as a disciple of Jesus this coming week?
- Pray that Jesus will help you make the choices that are right as you continue to learn to be his disciple.

And whoever gives one of these little ones even a cup of cold water because he is a disciple, truly, I say to you,

**he will by no means lose his reward.**

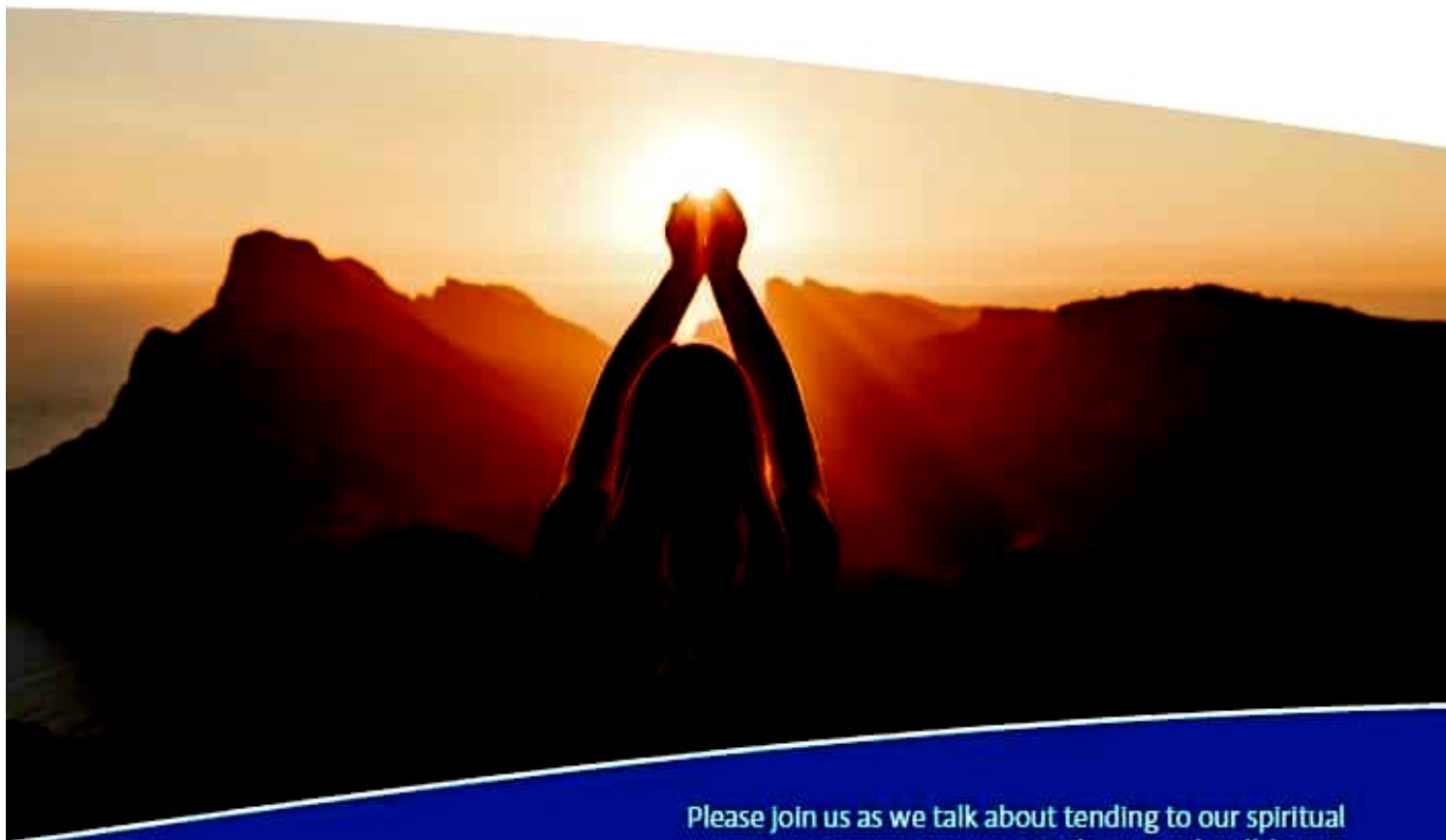

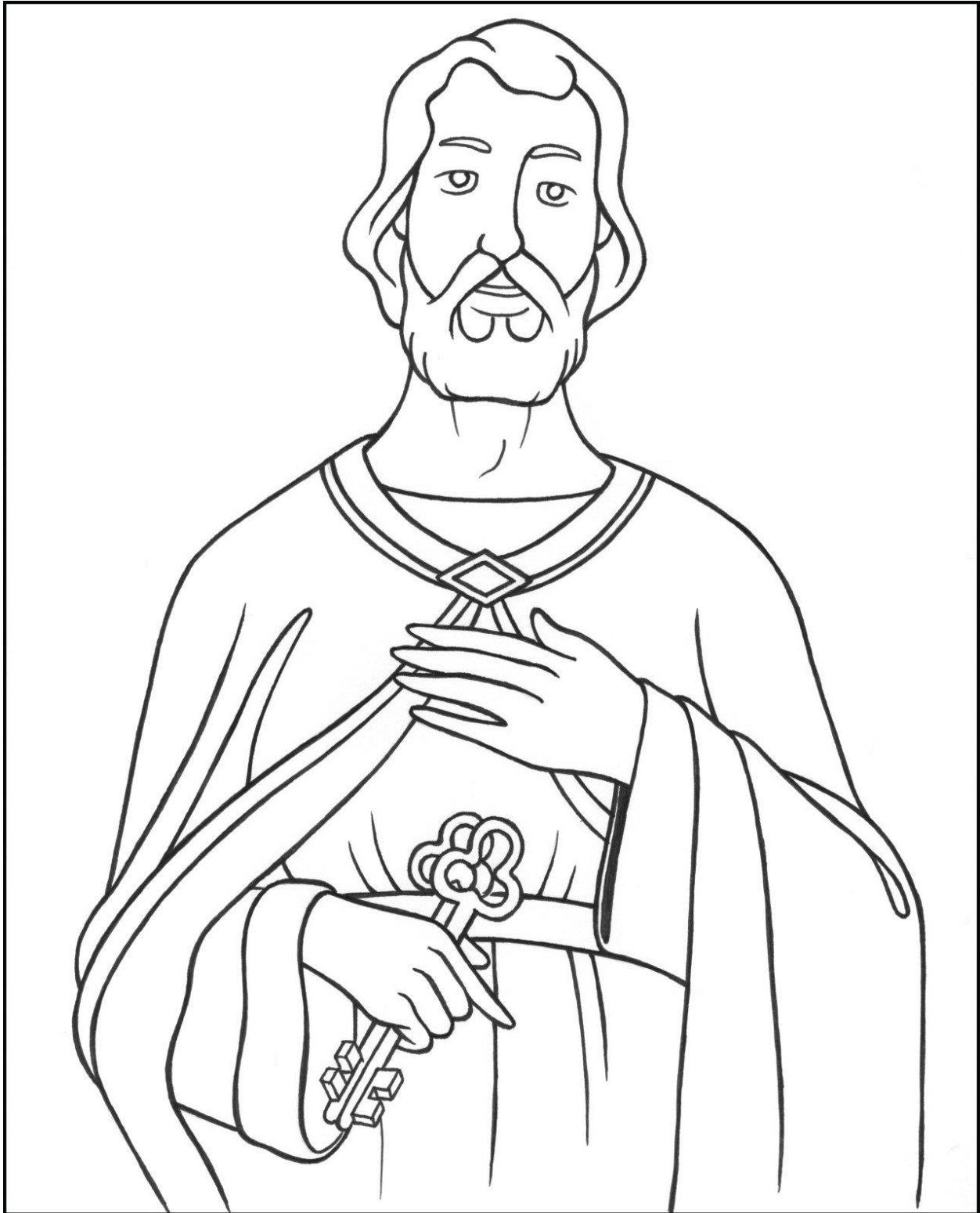
