## *A Message from our Pastor*



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Last weekend, we all were horrified to see the devastation that unfolded in Israel as Hamas terrorists attacked sections of Israel in an early morning, unprovoked display of horror. The stories of what happened to innocent children, grandparents, infants, women, and men are stomach-turning. In this age of social media, these images are not only ones to be imagined but can sadly be recorded and shared around the world in an instant. Understandably, Israel has responded with its own military attacks to fortify its borders and eradicate the militants. Regrettably, innocent Palestinians are often used as human shields by their own leaders, thus inflicting untold more death, injury, and destruction. As Catholics, we must commit ourselves to daily prayer that a just and lasting peace is established as quickly as possible. Such a goal may seem remote or even impossible. But with God, all things are possible. I urge you to commit to praying the Rosary during this month traditionally dedicated to this beautiful prayer. May the Mother of our Savior, the Mother of Peace, intercede on behalf of all those in the midst of war.

This Monday, October 16<sup>th</sup>, is the Feast of St. Gerard Majella. In addition to the usual morning Mass, there will be an additional time of prayer in the evening. We will recite the Rosary at 6:30pm for the protection of all human life, especially the preborn. It will be followed by Mass at 7:00pm. This is always a very moving time for families to pray in gratitude for the many blessings and miracles received through the intercession of our beloved patron. It's also a time for families, especially young couples, who are experiencing the pain of infertility, miscarriages, and other heartbreaking challenges, to ask St. Gerard to pray for them before the throne of God. Following Mass, there will be individual blessings with the relic of St. Gerard. You and your families are strongly encouraged to join us for this special Mass to offer praise and gratitude to God for the life and model of St. Gerard Majella.

Finally, I ask for your prayers for our dear friend, Deacon John. On Wednesday, he will undergo surgery for his recently diagnosed prostate cancer. He will then convalesce for about six weeks before returning to active, full ministry. His prognosis is very good, and he is in excellent hands with his surgeons and other doctors. We pray that his period of healing is swift and complete. I know Deacon John is grateful for your prayers and well wishes.

In these Autumn days, we experience the palpable changes all around us. The decrease of light, the changing of colors, the "lessening" of Summer glory – all of it is a reminder to us of the frailty and mortality of our lives. Yet, we can already anticipate the glory of Springtime after the hibernation of Winter. We know that, with God, there is always a new beginning, a new hope. In these majestic Fall days, may you experience the tremendous grace of renewed trust in the Almighty's care for you, your loved ones, and our world!

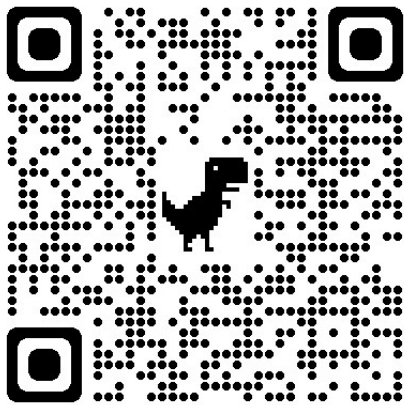

## Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

**October 22, 2023**

**Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**Mt 22:15-21**

The Pharisees went off and plotted how they might entrap Jesus in speech. They sent their disciples to him, with the Herodians, saying, "Teacher, we know that you are a truthful man and that you teach the way of God in accordance with the truth. And you are not concerned with anyone's opinion, for you do not regard a person's status. Tell us, then, what is your opinion: Is it lawful to pay the census tax to Caesar or not?" Knowing their malice, Jesus said, "Why are you testing me, you hypocrites? Show me the coin that pays the census tax." Then they handed him the Roman coin. He said to them, "Whose image is this and whose inscription?" They replied, "Caesar's." At that he said to them, "Then repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God."

### Reflection Questions

- Who came together to trap Jesus? What was unusual about this?
- How did Jesus diffuse their trap?
- What was the response of the people to Jesus' answer?
- What do you think Jesus meant when he told the Pharisees to give God what was due to God?
- Think about the times when you do not give God what is due to God. Even though there are times when we are not the person that God wants us to be—when we are not loyal to God—we can always ask forgiveness. When you are faced with choices this week, think about whether or not your decisions will honor your loyalty to God.



Next Sunday, we will celebrate World Mission Sunday. Pope Francis invites the entire Church to support mission dioceses in Africa, Asia, the Pacific Islands, and parts of Latin America and Europe, where priests, religious and lay leaders serve the world's most vulnerable communities. Please keep the Pope's missions in your prayers and be generous in next week's collection for the Society for the Propagation of the Faith.

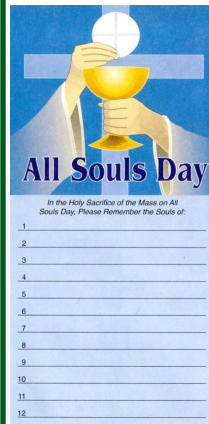

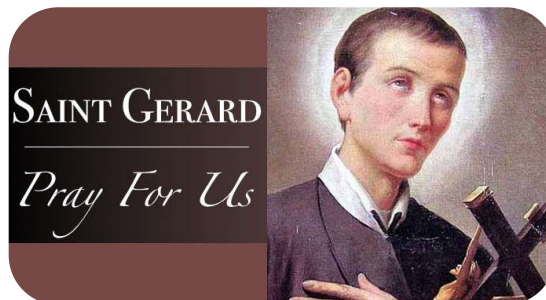
