A Message from our Pastor



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We Christians now enter the holiest week of the year. Today, we wave high our palm branches as did those crowds in Jerusalem as they welcomed Jesus. We sing that familiar chant, “Hosana to the Son of David,” and see the jubilation. But we know that those cheers will soon turn direction and be calls for the death of Jesus by the cruelest form possible – crucifixion. This week is one of twists and turns to be sure. The crowds turn away from Jesus. His own Apostles turn away from Him. But Jesus also turns things on their head. In Him, we see the perfect be delivered into the hands of the imperfect. We see the sinless pay for the sins of the world. The perfect lamb is sacrificed for the redemption of sinful souls. Ultimately, it will be the Resurrection of Christ – the greatest twist in the story of humanity – that will assure us the promise of everlasting life.

While we may enter this week with a mindset of repetition and familiar services, the challenge is always to see things with fresh eyes. Pray for the grace to experience the power of Holy Week in whatever particular way God intends it for you. We’re all different than we were last year, let alone a decade or more. This week is a time of freshness for us to experience the salvation Christ has won for us.

Please make every effort to join us for the various liturgies and times of prayer. They include:

- The **Sacrament of Confession** will be available on Monday from 2-4pm and 6-9pm in every parish in our diocese. Open your heart to the healing power of Christ’s forgiveness in the great sacrament of mercy. Never doubt in the compassion of God!
- The **Chrism Mass** will be celebrated on Tuesday at 4pm at the Cathedral of St. Agnes in Rockville Centre. All are welcome to attend this Mass in which the oils that will be used throughout the year are blessed and us priests renew the vows of our ordination. This Mass will also be shown on Catholic Faith Network (CFN) live and again at 8pm.
- **Morning Prayer** will be prayed in the church at 9am on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday.
- The principal liturgies of **Holy Thursday** and **Good Friday** recall the Last Supper, Agony in the Garden, the crucifixion, and death of our Blessed Lord. We’ll also have Stations of the Cross prayed twice on Good Friday.
- **Easter Sunday** will surely see great crowds coming to our parish to commemorate the Resurrection of Christ. Thank you for your patience as you come to Mass and your welcoming spirit to those who may be visiting for the first time in a while.

We look forward to celebrating together as a parish family these most sacred days of our faith. May you have a meaningful and truly Holy Week.

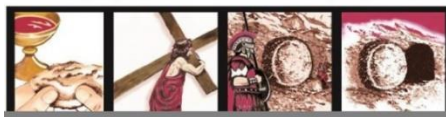

Palm Sunday Craft

Supplies to make 2 Hosanna Branch Wavers:

Green construction paper- 4 sheets, 4-8 jumbo craft sticks, Clear tape, A pencil, Scissors, A glue-stick

Instructions:

1. Outline your child's hand on the green construction paper. (Make a minimum of 6 outlines. 8-10 will make your child's waver really wave!)
2. If your child is old enough to use a pair of scissors, allow him/her to cut around the handprint outlines. Else leave this part to the adult supervising the craft.
3. Now stick the handprint outlines two on each row and build on upwards.
4. Finally tape two craft sticks to the bottom of the "branch" securely with the tape. (©Mommy Snippets)

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

March 31, 2024

Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord

Jn 20:1-9

On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb. So she ran and went to Simon Peter and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and told them, "They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they put him." So Peter and the other disciple went out and came to the tomb. They both ran, but the other disciple ran faster than Peter and arrived at the tomb first; he bent down and saw the burial cloths there, but did not go in. When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.

Reflection Questions

- How does the resurrection narrative in John 20 deepen your understanding of the Gospel?
- If you were Mary of Magdala, Simon Peter, or the beloved disciple, what would you have thought when you found the stone removed and Jesus' tomb empty?
- What did Mary of Magdala, Simon Peter, and the disciple whom Jesus loved think had happened?
- What can we learn about faith from Mary Magdalene's encounter with the resurrected Jesus?
- During Lent we prepared ourselves to remember and celebrate Jesus' death and Resurrection. During the season of Easter, the Church asks us to reflect on Jesus' Resurrection and what it means for us as his disciples today. We can spend time during the Easter season thinking about Jesus' Resurrection and the gift of eternal life that he gives to us.

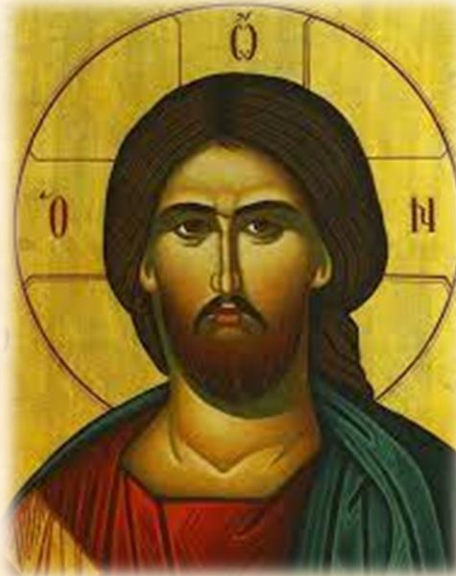

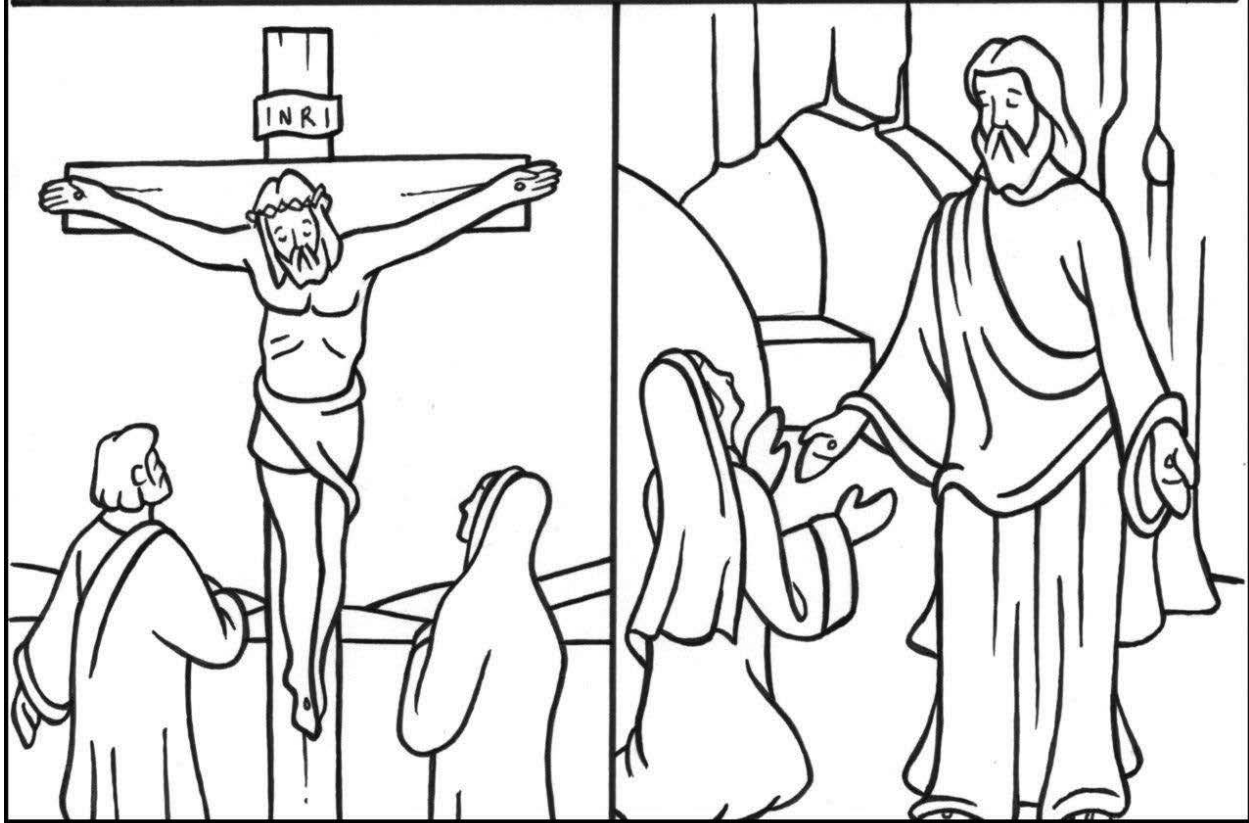

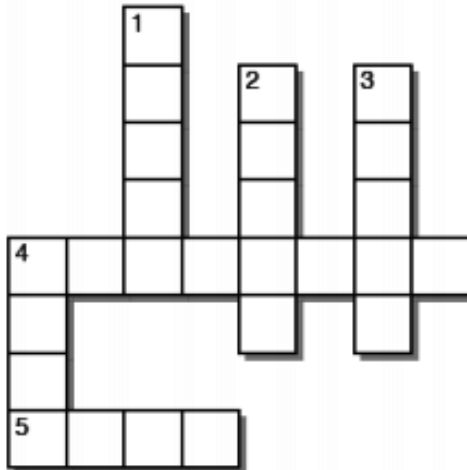
