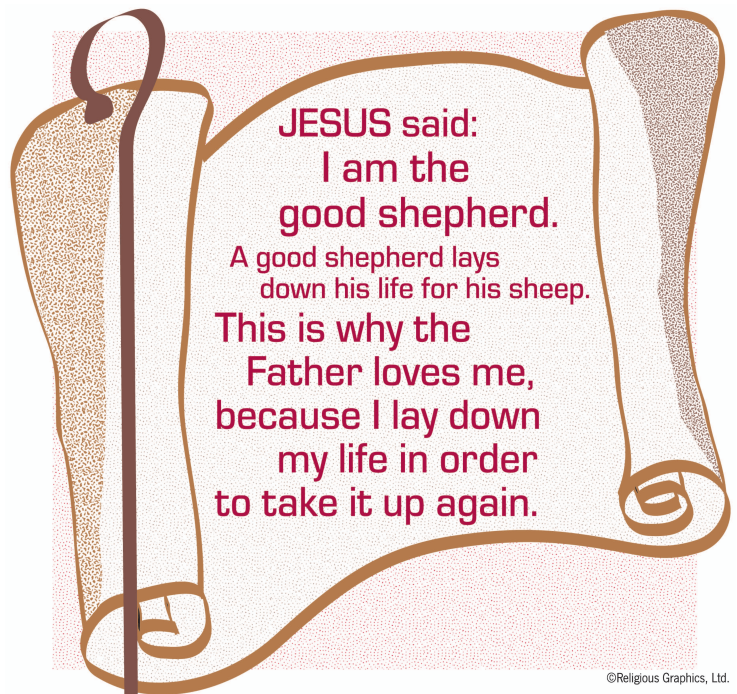

Fourth Sunday of Easter

A Message from our Pastor



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This Fourth Sunday of the Easter Season is often referred to as “Good Shepherd Sunday”! We hear, in the tenth chapter of St. John’s Gospel, Jesus calling himself just that – the Good Shepherd, who lays down His life for His flock. Reflecting on this Sunday’s gospel gives us an opportunity to ponder the goodness of Christ, our Shepherd. It also prompts us to pray for those who shepherd us in the Church today, namely our clergy. And, to say it more emphatically, this is a critical time for us to pray for an increase of vocations to the priesthood. We don’t need to be reminded that the number of men entering seminary and being ordained has dropped drastically over the past three decades. Some even use the term “crisis” to describe the current state of vocations in the Church today.

On June 8th, Bishop Barres will ordain two young men to the Priesthood for our diocese. They are bright, energetic, smart, and talented men, who will no doubt be wonderful assets to the parishes they serve. But the sobering reality is that those two priests will not replace those priests who will be retiring this year or who have had to step away from ministry because of sickness. Even our own situation – a cooperative effort of the clergy between our two parishes – is evidence that we are in desperate need of more men to become priests.

So, you might ask: “What can I do to fix this?” In short, two things. First, pray every day for an increase of vocations to the priesthood. I really don’t believe it is a matter of God not calling men to this way of life, but rather an inability on their part to hear God’s voice because of the cacophony of voices impeding their minds. Second, encourage the young men around you to consider priesthood. Simply by asking a son, grandson, nephew, or young man in our neighborhood if he has ever thought of priesthood could make all the difference. I know it did for me! And nearly fifteen years on in my ministry, I can honestly say that it is a decision I don’t regret at all!

And, please pray for those of us who are priests. Pray that we are ardent, zealous ministers of souls. Pray that our numbers increase so that the flock of Christ may have enough shepherds to tend it until we all stand before the Good Shepherd in the halls of heaven!

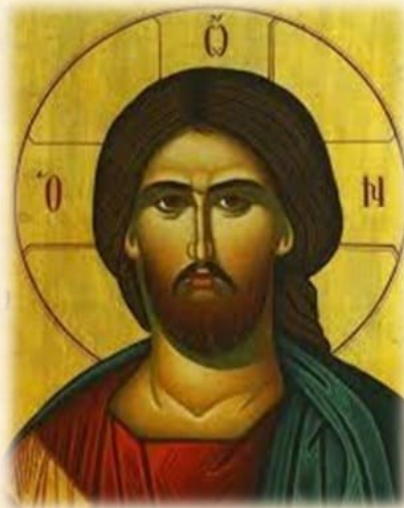

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

April 28, 2024

Fifth Sunday of Easter

Jn 15:1-8

Jesus said to his disciples:

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower. He takes away every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and every one that does he prunes so that it bears more fruit. You are already pruned because of the word that I spoke to you. Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me. I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit, because without me you can do nothing. Anyone who does not remain in me will be thrown out like a branch and wither; people will gather them and throw them into a fire and they will be burned. If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask for whatever you want and it will be done for you. By this is my Father glorified, that you bear much fruit and become my disciples."

Reflection Questions

- How does Jesus say we will recognize an expert disciple, or Christian? What do you think Jesus means by this?
- What does Jesus say will allow a person to bear this kind of fruit?
- Our relationship with Jesus, the true vine, strengthens us to be disciples, who bear good fruit and give glory to God. This relationship is strengthened when we read Scripture, when we pray, and especially when we receive the Body and Blood of Christ in Holy Communion. Choose an action for this week that will show your desire to strengthen your relationship with Jesus.
- What are the ways in which we are invited to relate to Jesus as his disciples today—prayer, Scripture, the Eucharist?
