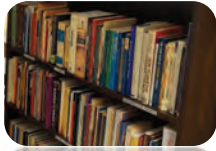

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

May 26, 2024

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

Mt 28:16-20

The eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had ordered them. When they all saw him, they worshiped, but they doubted. Then Jesus approached and said to them, "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age."

Reflection Questions

- What was the first thing the disciples did when they saw Jesus at the place where He told them to go?
- What did Jesus mean when He said all authority had been given to Him? Who gave Him that authority?
- What kind of authority did Christ have and pass on to us?
- Throughout Jesus' life and ministry, He gave many commands to His disciples. As His disciples, we are called to observe, obey, and follow all that Christ has commanded us. What are one or two areas that you are working on to obey Christ?
- How are you being disciplined and how are you disciplining others?

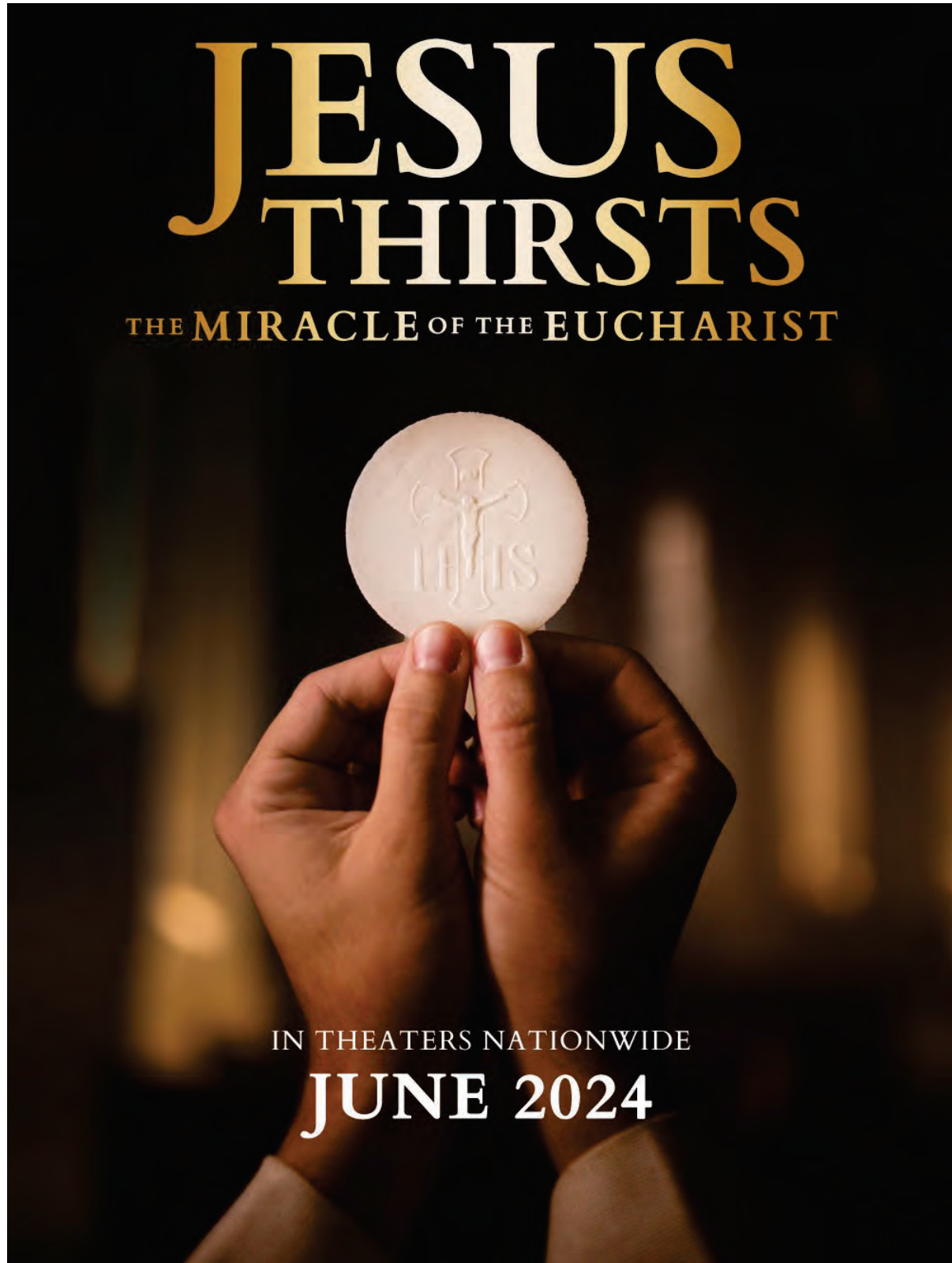
