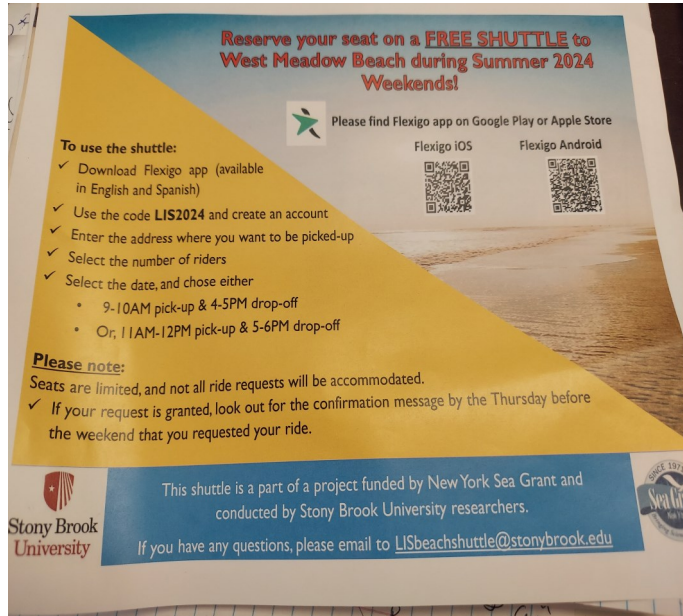

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

June 23, 2024

Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Mk 4:35-41

On that day, as evening drew on, Jesus said to his disciples:

"Let us cross to the other side."

Leaving the crowd, they took Jesus with them in the boat just as he was. And other boats were with him. A violent squall came up and waves were breaking over the boat, so that it was already filling up. Jesus was in the stern, asleep on a cushion. They woke him and said to him, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" He woke up, rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Quiet! Be still!"

The wind ceased and there was great calm.

Then he asked them, "Why are you terrified?

Do you not yet have faith?"

They were filled with great awe and said to one another,

"Who then is this whom even wind and sea obey?"

Reflection Questions

- What do you think Mark means by saying in verse 36 that the disciples took Jesus just as he was. What do you think the disciples understood about Jesus at this point?
- What do you make of the fact that Jesus was sleeping during the storm?
- Based on Jesus' response to them, how should the disciples have responded in the midst of this storm?
- What does the calming of the storm reveal about who Jesus is?
- Why do you think the disciples are more terrified after the storm than before? In what ways might it be both comforting and terrifying to be in Jesus' presence?
- Do you trust that Jesus is fully God and in control of the storms? How is that helpful to you and how do you exhibit that kind of faith in difficult times?
- Do you trust that Jesus loves you and cares for you even as He allows you to endure the storms of life?
