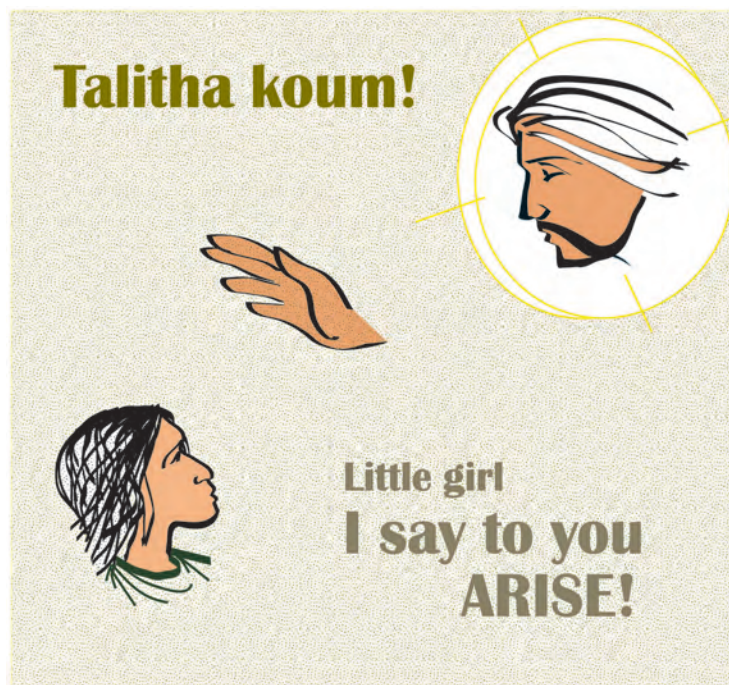

A Message from our Pastor



Dear Friends of Infant Jesus & St. Gerard's,

As many of you are probably aware, Fr. Rolando will be departing Infant Jesus at the end of July. After 11 years of faithful ministry to our community, Fr. Rolando will begin a new chapter in his priestly ministry at St. John the Evangelist in Riverhead. We will have a celebration to bid Father well on Sunday, July 28th. Details will be forthcoming but mark your calendars now!

Fr. Francis has left for his well-deserved time away back in India to catch up with family and friends. This weekend, we welcome back Bishop Tony who will be with us until the end of July. He will be offering a scripture course in the church of Infant Jesus as he has done before. See this weekend's bulletin for more details.

On Monday, we will welcome Fr. Sijomon Varghese who will succeed Fr. Rolando as a parochial vicar here. Like the other clergy, he will be present to both parishes, though he will have a particular role in coordinating the activities of the Spanish-speaking community largely located at Infant Jesus. Father Sijomon has been a priest for 15 years and did his studies at St. Joseph's Pontifical Seminary in Kerala, India. In addition to serving at parishes in his native diocese, for the last few years he has served in a parish in Spain. Father arrived in the United States only a couple of months ago and is eager to learn about our culture and the vibrancy of our parish.

On a personal note, last week marked several milestones for me personally. On June 27th, I celebrated fifteen years of ordination to the priesthood and six years as Pastor of St. Gerard's. Last Saturday, June 29th, marked two years of me serving as Pastor of Infant Jesus. These moments give me pause to consider the many blessings I have experienced as a priest, most especially in the role of Pastor. I'm grateful for your love and support demonstrated in many ways. Know that you, your intentions, and your families are in my prayers each day. Please keep me and my brother clergy in yours as well.

As we enter into the heart of summer, I hope you are able to take advantage of the beauty of creation, the joy of being with family and friends, and basking in the reality of God's presence in your life!

HEAP Cooling Assistance Component

The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) Cooling Assistance Component (CAC) provides for the purchase and installation of an air conditioner or fan. CAC benefits are available to HEAP eligible households containing at least one individual with a documented medical condition that is exacerbated by extreme heat and verified in writing by a physician, physical assistant, or nurse practitioner. Applicant households that received a Regular HEAP benefit greater than \$21 during the current program year, received a benefit equal to \$21 during the current program year and reside in government subsidized housing with heat included in their shelter costs, or are currently in receipt of ongoing Temporary Assistance or Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits, AND who have not moved since receiving a current program year Regular HEAP benefit, may apply by phone by calling the Office for the Aging HEAP Hotline at 631-853-8326.

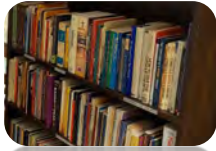

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

July 7, 2024

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Mk 6:1-6

Jesus departed from there and came to his native place, accompanied by his disciples. When the sabbath came he began to teach in the synagogue, and many who heard him were astonished. They said, "Where did this man get all this? What kind of wisdom has been given him? What mighty deeds are wrought by his hands! Is he not the carpenter, the son of Mary, and the brother of James and Joses and Judas and Simon? And are not his sisters here with us?" And they took offense at him. Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his native place and among his own kin and in his own house." So he was not able to perform any mighty deed there, apart from curing a few sick people by laying his hands on them. He was amazed at their lack of faith.

Reflection Questions

- How do the people of Nazareth respond to Jesus in this passage?
- What's insinuated in the questions they ask about Jesus?
- What wrong conclusions are they drawing?
- How did Jesus react to their rejection?
- How do you think it's possible for people to see what Jesus has done and be astonished by it, yet not believe in Him?
- How does faith in Jesus as the Son of God transform your relationship with God and with one another?
- Pray this week that your family will continue to help each other follow God in their lives.
