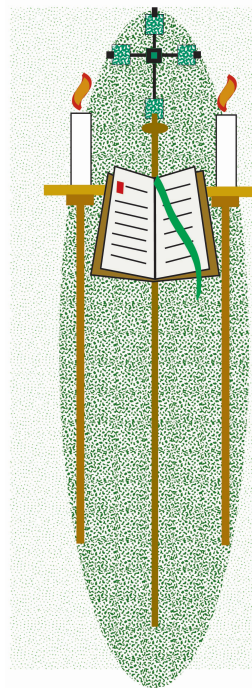

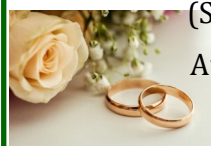

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

July 21, 2024

Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Mk 6:30-34

The apostles gathered together with Jesus and reported all they had done and taught.

He said to them,
"Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while."

People were coming and going in great numbers, and they had no opportunity even to eat. So they went off in the boat by themselves to a deserted place. People saw them leaving and many came to know about it. They hastened there on foot from all the towns and arrived at the place before them.

When he disembarked and saw the vast crowd, his heart was moved with pity for them, for they were like sheep without a shepherd; and he began to teach them many things.

Reflection Questions

- Why does Jesus instruct the disciples to take some time to rest?
- Despite needing rest, we're told that Jesus showed compassion to the great crowd. In what way specifically did He exhibit His compassion for them?
- What does the description 'like sheep without a shepherd' convey about the people? What do good shepherds provide for their sheep?
- Did it surprise you that Jesus' compassion for the people was first displayed through teaching them? Why or why not?
- Sometimes people's 'felt needs' are different than their real needs. In sharing the gospel with others, how can we get beyond people's 'felt needs' to their real needs?
- How will you go about seeing and savoring Jesus this week?

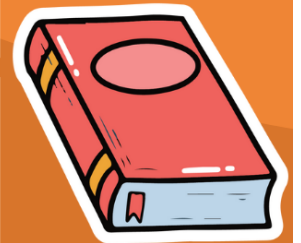
