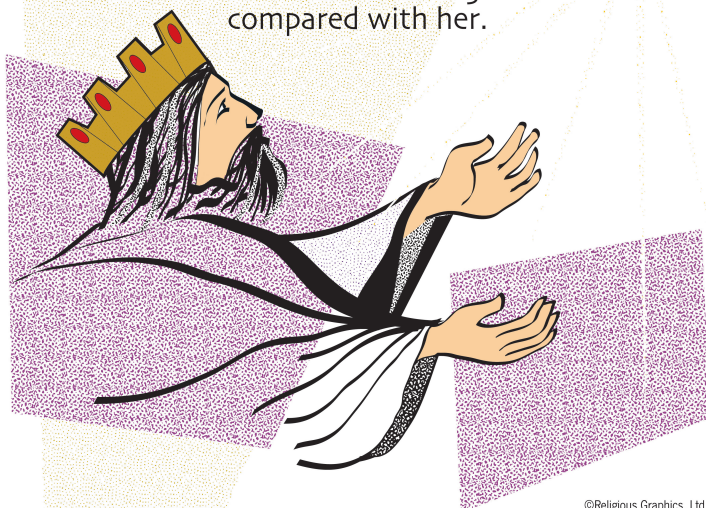

## *Breaking Open the Word*

**Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?**

**October 20, 2024**

**Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**Mk 10:35-45**

James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came to Jesus and said to him, "Teacher, we want you to do for us whatever we ask of you." He replied, "What do you wish me to do for you?" They answered him, "Grant that in your glory we may sit one at your right and the other at your left." Jesus said to them, "You do not know what you are asking. Can you drink the cup that I drink or be baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized?" They said to him, "We can." Jesus said to them, "The cup that I drink, you will drink, and with the baptism with which I am baptized, you will be baptized; but to sit at my right or at my left is not mine to give but is for those for whom it has been prepared." When the ten heard this, they became indignant at James and John. Jesus summoned them and said to them, "You know that those who are recognized as rulers over the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great ones make their authority over them felt. But it shall not be so among you. Rather, whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant; whoever wishes to be first among you will be the slave of all. For the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many."

### *Reflection Questions*

- Why did Jesus say that James and John didn't really understand what they were asking? What were they missing?
- Why were the rest of the disciples indignant with James and John?
- What does it mean that Jesus came to "give his life as a ransom"?
- How would you answer someone who asked you, "Why did Jesus have to die?"
- In whatever work you're called to do, what are some of the ways you can go about your work in order to communicate that you understand your calling to be that of a servant?
- Have you asked God for anything over the past week? What did you pray for? What does that teach you about yourself? What might you now pray for in light of this passage?

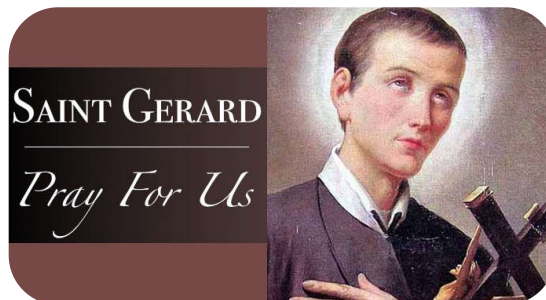

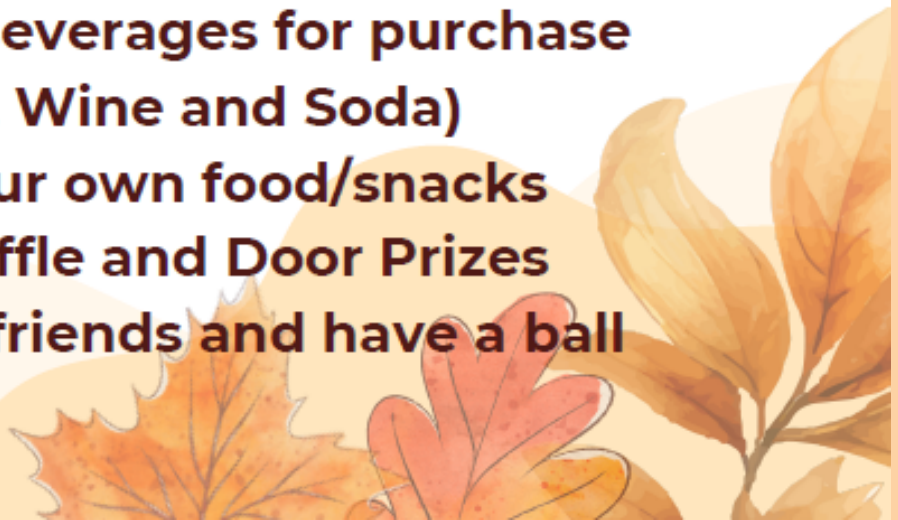
