## *Breaking Open the Word*

**Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?**

***December 29, 2024***

***Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph***

***Lk 2:41-52***

Each year Jesus' parents went to Jerusalem for the feast of Passover, and when he was twelve years old, they went up according to festival custom. After they had completed its days, as they were returning, the boy Jesus remained behind in Jerusalem, but his parents did not know it. Thinking that he was in the caravan, they journeyed for a day and looked for him among their relatives and acquaintances, but not finding him, they returned to Jerusalem to look for him. After three days they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions, and all who heard him were astounded at his understanding and his answers. When his parents saw him, they were astonished, and his mother said to him, "Son, why have you done this to us? Your father and I have been looking for you with great anxiety." And he said to them, "Why were you looking for me? Did you not know that I must be in my Father's house?" But they did not understand what he said to them. He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was obedient to them; and his mother kept all these things in her heart. And Jesus advanced in wisdom and age and favor before God and man.

### ***Reflection Questions***

- Joseph & Mary assumed Jesus was with the caravan. What kind of suffering/emotions did they experience when they realized they had lost sight of Jesus? What kind of suffering happens when we lose sight of Jesus today?
- How did Jesus interact with the teachers of the law, and what does this tell us about Jesus?
- What emotion did Mary say they experienced while searching for Jesus? How does sorrow/distress play a part in seeking Jesus today?
- Jesus responded in obedience to his earthly parents and returned to Nazareth when he could have continued to learn in the temple. How does this show his trust in God's timing and faithfulness to God's law?
- What treasures have I stored up about Christ in my heart and what daily/weekly practices are helping me grow in wisdom and understanding of God's word?

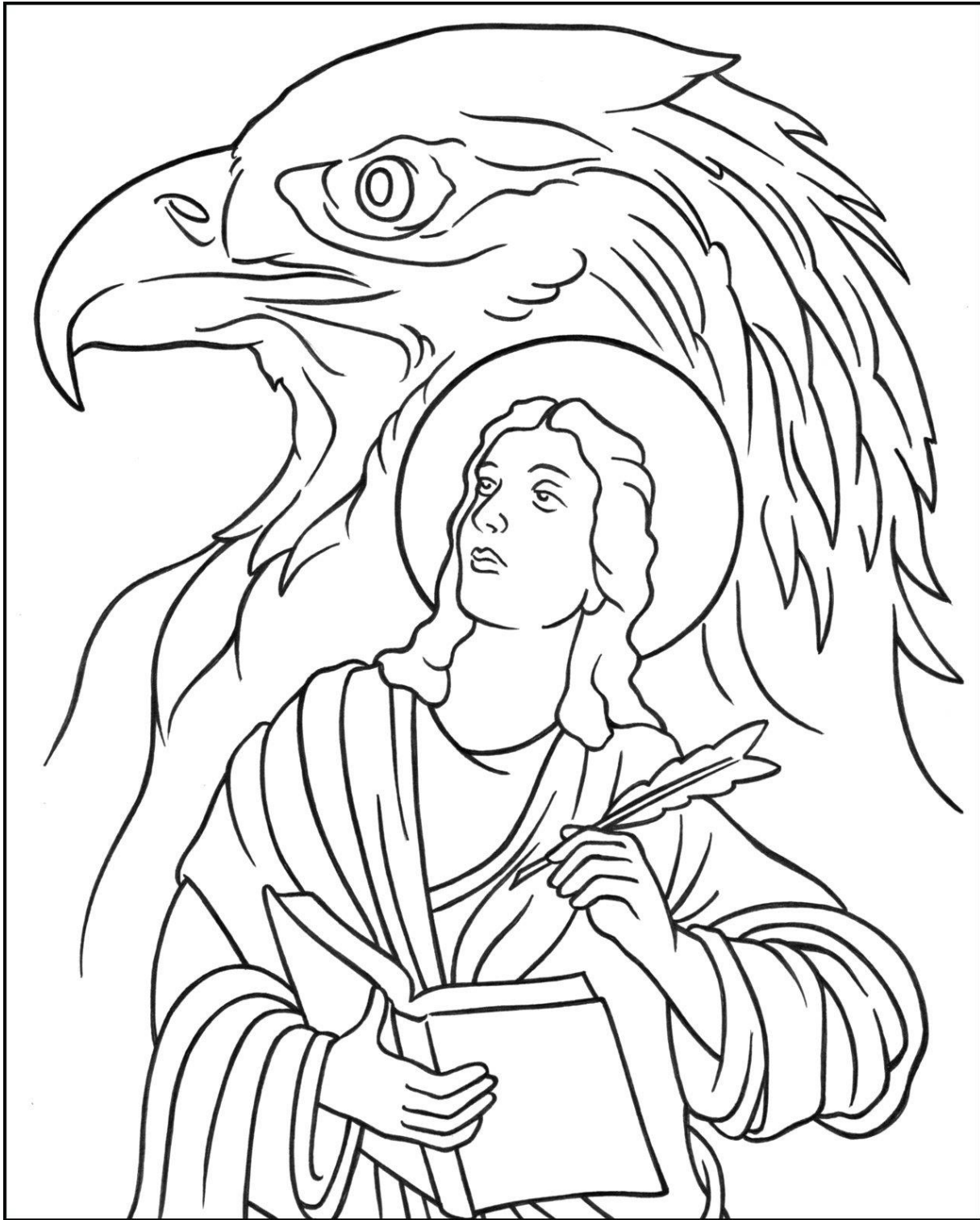
