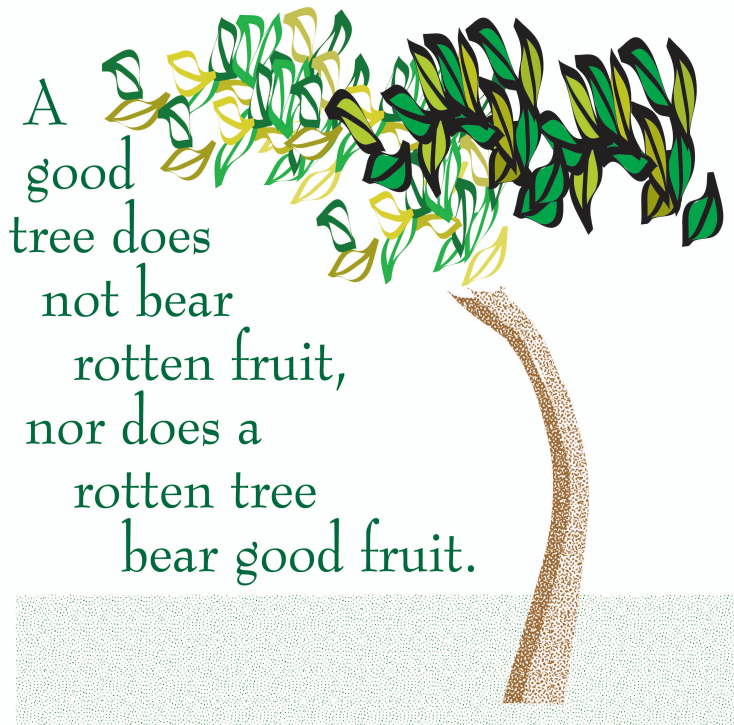

## *A Message from our Pastor*



Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Here it comes; ready or not! By that, of course, I mean that we are about to embark on the sacred preparatory Season of Lent.

On Wednesday, we will have the familiar practice of being marked with ashes--a reminder of both our *origin* and our *end*. We are dust, and it is to dust that we shall return. But we know that, what we will celebrate at the end of these Forty Days is that the end is a change. Because of the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Christ, we are made new, and we are given the promise of everlasting life. Such a celebration of newness deserves serious preparation. The final night will be the monthly Holy Hour, our participation in an exciting initiative by our diocese, Return to Me: 40 Days of Eucharistic Adoration. This initiative provides the faithful throughout the Diocese of Rockville Centre with the opportunity to encounter the Lord in Eucharistic Adoration during the Lenten season at forty different parishes. May you have a fruitful and meaningful Lenten Season! We will see each other in Church as we each seek to deepen our discipleship and we each take up our cross to follow our Savior to Calvary and to the empty tomb!

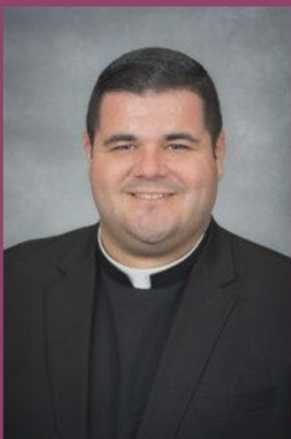

*This coming week, we celebrate Ash Wednesday, the first day of the liturgical season of Lent. In this season, we prepare ourselves to celebrate the high point of our Christian life, Easter. Each year, the readings for Ash Wednesday are the same. They call us to a change of heart and teach us about the traditional Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. These disciplines are to be part of the Christian life during every season, but during the season of Lent, we renew our commitment to them.*

*The meaning behind tracing a cross on our foreheads with ashes (the liturgical sign of Ash Wednesday) is a summary of our Christian life. On one level, the ashes remind us of our origin and our death. (In the words of the prayer said when we receive ashes: "Remember that you are dust and to dust you shall return.") The ashes are also the sign of our victory: the cross of Christ. In his death and resurrection, Christ conquered death. Our destiny as Christians is to receive the victory over death that Christ won for us. We acknowledge that victory when we "[t]urn away from sin and [are] faithful to the gospel," words from the alternative prayer when we are signed with ashes.*

## Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

**March 9, 2025**

**First Sunday of Lent**

**Lk 4:1-13**

Filled with the Holy Spirit, Jesus returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the desert for forty days, to be tempted by the devil. He ate nothing during those days, and when they were over he was hungry. The devil said to him,

"If you are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread."

Jesus answered him,

"It is written, *One does not live on bread alone.*"

Then he took him up and showed him all the kingdoms of the world in a single instant.

The devil said to him,

"I shall give to you all this power and glory; for it has been handed over to me, and I may give it to whomever I wish.

All this will be yours, if you worship me."

Jesus said to him in reply,

"It is written

*You shall worship the Lord, your God,  
and him alone shall you serve.*"

Then he led him to Jerusalem, made him stand on the parapet of the temple, and said to him,

"If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down from here, for it is written:

*He will command his angels concerning you, to guard you,*

and: *With their hands they will support you, lest you dash your foot against a stone.*"

Jesus said to him in reply,

"It also says,

*You shall not put the Lord, your God, to the test.*"

When the devil had finished every temptation, he departed from him for a time.

### Reflection Questions

- Why do you think Jesus went into the wilderness for 40 days? What did Jesus do for those 40 days in the wilderness?
- Some have compared Jesus' temptation with the temptation of Adam and Eve (Gen. 3:1-7), as well as Israel in the wilderness (Num.14:34). What are some commonalities? What do they suggest about who Jesus is?
- How did Satan use Jesus' hunger and power to tempt Him to be a bad son? Explain Jesus' response? What does this teach us about resisting temptation?
- How did Satan's enticement to jump off of the pinnacle of the temple tempt Jesus to be a bad son? Explain Jesus response? What does this teach us about resisting temptation?
- In what ways does Jesus' example in this reading provide guidance for dealing with temptation, rejection, and the demands of ministry in our lives?

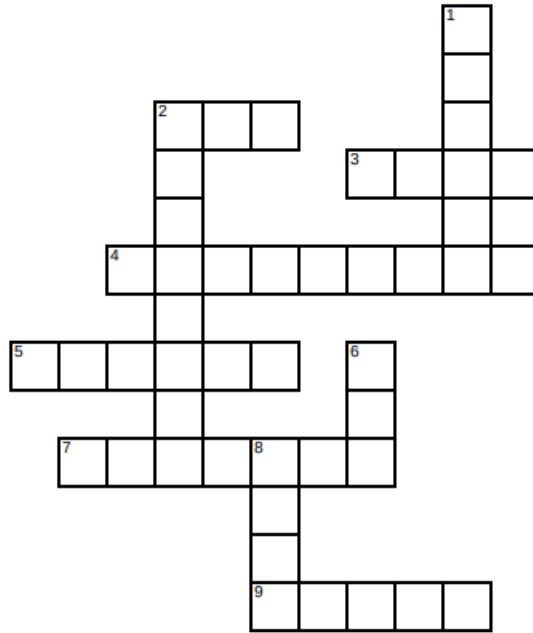
