## A Message from our Pastor



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today we commence the holiest of weeks in our faith. We recall with reverence and devotion the most pivotal moments in salvation history – the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of our Blessed Savior. We're not meant simply to be spectators of these events and remember them as something from centuries ago. We are challenged to see how those salvific events are at play in our own lives right here and now. All of us are works in progress – we struggle each day to allow the light of Christ to shine in and through us despite the relentless darkness that tries to invade and claw back progress. At times we are the crowds we hear in today's Gospel, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is He who comes!" Yet at other moments, we can unintentionally be yelling to crucify Jesus by our actions or inactions towards others.

Please be sure to look at the schedule of liturgies this week and plan on joining in as much as you can. On Monday, we will have the **Sacrament of Confession** available from 2:00-4:00pm and 6:00-9:00pm. On Tuesday at 4:00pm during the **Chrism Mass**, Bishop Barres will be joined by the priests of the diocese to bless the holy oils that will be used in our parish throughout the year. We priests also renew the promises we made on our ordination day. Please pray for us who are called to serve you, the faithful, to bring the presence of Christ to our communities through the scriptures and sacramental life of the Church. Anyone may join for the Mass at St. Agnes Cathedral or watch on Catholic Faith Network.

The **Sacred Paschal Triduum** consists of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Sunday. Each day, there are several times for public prayer to commemorate the turning point in human history when sin and death were trampled by the immense love and mercy of Christ. Join us, as best as you can, to experience God's transforming grace in your heart and mind.

## Palm Crosses

Follow the instructions below to create your own palm cross!



**1** Holding a palm strip with the curled edge toward you, fold up the widest end in a loop about 2" long.



**2** Then fold the top piece downward until it covers the top of the previous fold and forms a loop about 2". Place a staple at the intersection.



**3** Bend the thin end of the palm to the right, creasing on a diagonal line.



**4** Fold the palm behind the cross, forming a loop about 1 1/2" on the left. Secure in the center with another staple.



**5** Continue the fold toward the front of the cross forming a loop 1 1/2" on the left. Secure it with another staple.



**6** Wrap the remainder of the palm over the top-right angle of the cross, bringing it straight across the back and over the top-left angle to the front. Cross it diagonally to the bottom-right corner ...



**7** ... straight across the back and bring it to the front from the bottom-left corner. Bring it from the bottom-left corner to the top-right corner and to the back again.



**8** Weave the small remaining piece in the back under loops and tie it off. If needed, you can use another staple or a drop of glue.



**9** Add dried flowers or a tiny bow.

## Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

**April 20, 2025**

***The Resurrection of the Lord  
The Mass of Easter Day***

***John 20:1-9***

On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb. So she ran and went to Simon Peter and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and told them, "They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they put him." So Peter and the other disciple went out and came to the tomb. They both ran, but the other disciple ran faster than Peter and arrived at the tomb first; he bent down and saw the burial cloths there, but did not go in. When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.

### ***Reflection Questions***

- Given the disciples' response, why is Mary crying?
- Mary was seeking the dead and buried Jesus, but her grief blinded her from seeing that he was right there present with her. How might grief blind a person today from being aware of the presence of God?
- Mary Magdalene was seeking Jesus in one way and meets Him in another. How does this occur in our lives?
- The beloved disciple went in, saw and believed. What did he see and what led him to believe? Why is it that the text tells us only the reaction of the beloved disciple and not that of Peter?
- What struck you in this text that describes the first experience of the resurrection?
- How does the Risen Christ give you the courage to believe in and share the Good News of Easter? How does Jesus open your eyes to His Presence in your daily life?

***Lord Jesus, we thank You for the Word that has enabled us to understand better the will of the Father. May Your Spirit enlighten our actions and grant us the strength to practice what Your Word has revealed to us. May we, like Mary, Your mother, not only listen to but also practice the Word, You who live and reign with the Father in the unity of the Holy Spirit forever and ever.  
Amen.***

### ***Palm Sunday Prayer***

God, You are indeed King of Kings and I am blessed by Your love and mercy. May my day today be guided by Your spirit and may I approach any obstacles knowing that my life and our world all belong to Your kingdom. Heavenly Father, crowds cheered and welcomed Jesus and later yelled for his crucifixion. I try to honor and celebrate You, but I know there are areas of my life where I reject or ignore You. Today, give me the strength to sing Your praises at times I might otherwise dishonor You.
