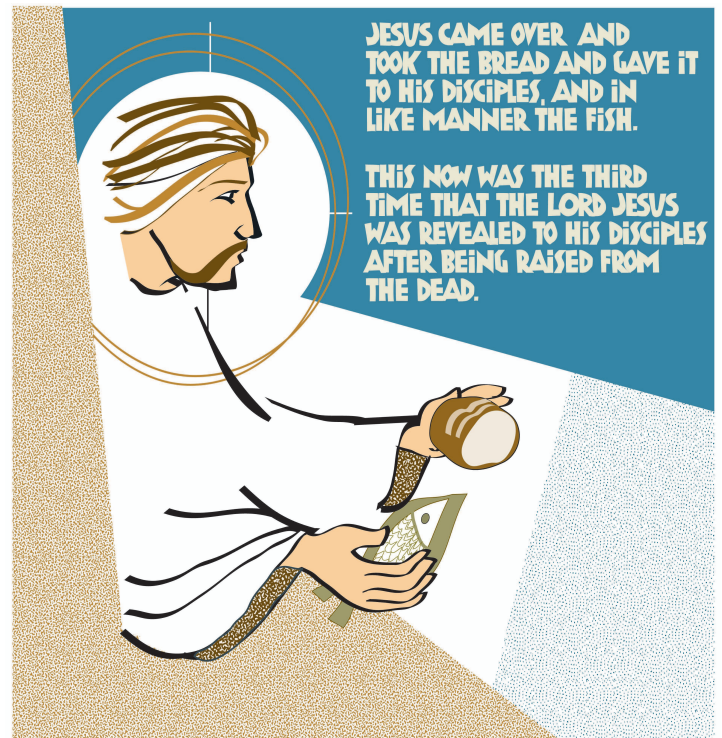

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

May 11, 2025

Fourth Sunday of Easter

John 10:27-30

Jesus said:

“My sheep hear my voice;
I know them, and they follow me.
I give them eternal life, and they shall never
perish.
No one can take them out of my hand.
My Father, who has given them to me, is greater
than all, and no one can take them out of the
Father's hand.
The Father and I are one.”

Reflection Questions

- What are the metaphors Jesus uses in today's Gospel to describe his relationship with his followers? (sheep and shepherd; recognizing voices) What kinds of things do these metaphors represent to us?
- In this Gospel, Jesus also describes his relationship with the Father. How does Jesus describe this relationship? This means that to know Jesus is to know the Father. Jesus doesn't just bring us closer to the Father, Jesus puts us directly into contact with God the Father, removing all distance between us. Throughout our life, we hope and pray that we will grow ever closer to God as we learn to follow Jesus more fully.
- Jesus said, “My sheep hear my voice.” Do You? Maybe in your heart? Or in homilies, or in the poor, or in people around you? In books, poems, nature? Any of the above? All of the above?

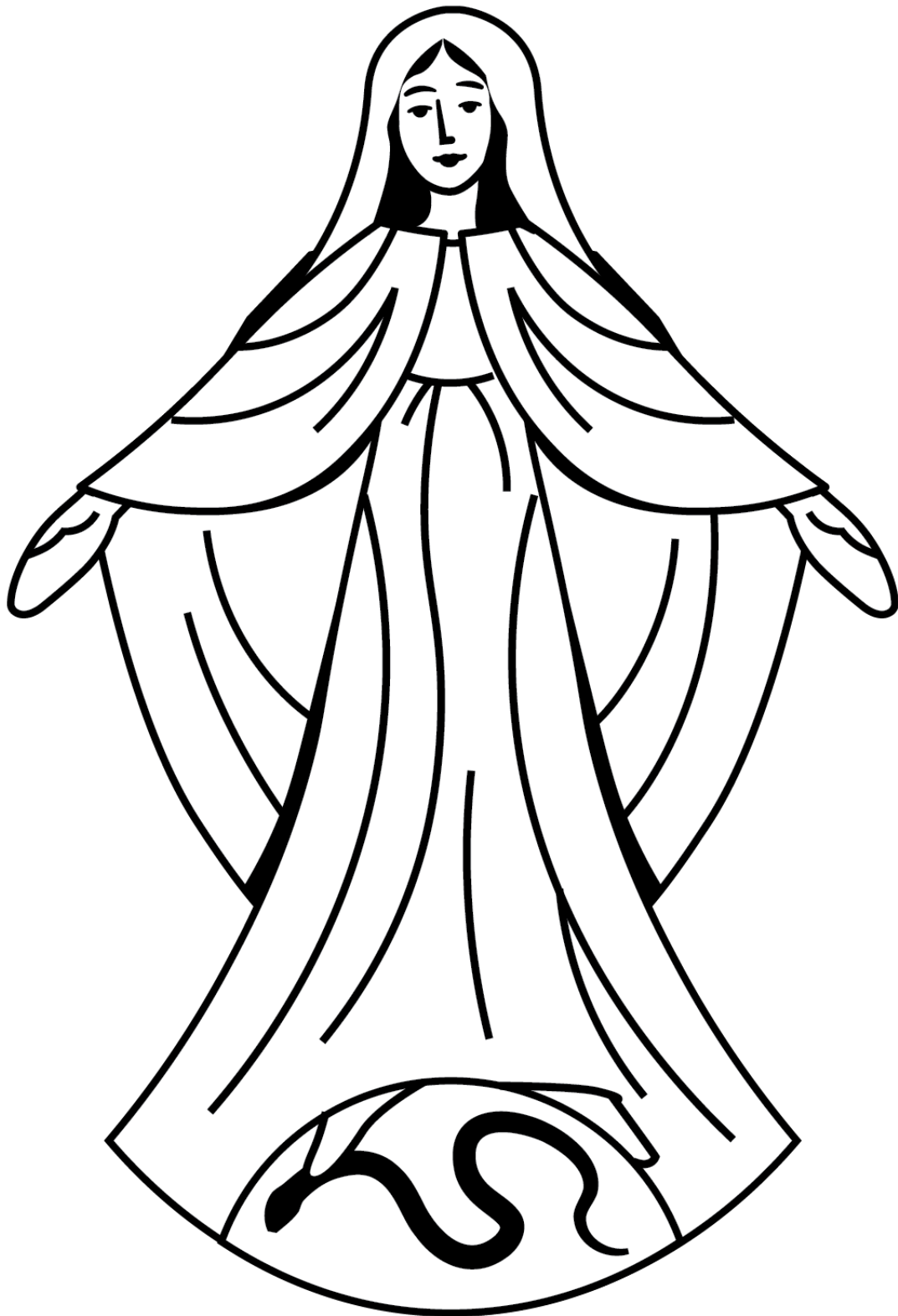
