A Message from our Pastor



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Shepherds. Who are they in your life? Who are the people who have influenced you to be who you are today? This is an important question for each of us to ask ourselves periodically. It helps to remind us of an important reality: none of us is really “self-made.” Yes, we have free will, a conscience, and a variety of life choices we make. But we’re shaped by those people in our lives, from childhood until now, who influence and guide us. Of course, above all we have Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, Who is the Way, the Truth, and Life itself. But we also have other people in our lives who shepherd us along life’s journey – parents, siblings, relatives, teachers, coaches, mentors, clergy, etc. This weekend, we recall three distinct shepherds.

First, we honor and pray for our mothers – living and deceased – in whose bodies we were conceived and nourished until our birth, and who sustained us through the most vulnerable first stages of our existence. Whether they are still on this side of life or have returned to the Father’s House, we pray that they be rewarded for their goodness.

Second, one Mother stands out among all, since she is the spiritual mother to us all – our Blessed Mother. Of all the images of the Blessed Mother that we read in the scriptures or see depicted in art, one of my favorites is Mary gathered with the Apostles in the Upper Room awaiting the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. She gathers with her Son’s closest friends and intercedes for them. Mary does the same for us today. In this month dedicated to the Blessed Mother, let’s be sure we ask her prayerfully to join us on our life’s journey by praying the Rosary and by heeding her example of faithful discipleship.

Finally, our Church – specifically her Pastors who are commissioned to be the shepherds guiding the faithful toward salvation. Those of us called to ordained ministry have the responsibility of teaching, governing, and sanctifying all Christians in the richness of our Catholic Faith. At my writing of this letter, we still don’t know who our new Pope is. Probably, though, as you’re reading this, we do. No matter who has been elected as the Successor of St. Peter, we pray that he be a good and faithful steward of the mysteries of our Faith, and one who boldly proclaims the Resurrection of Christ and His presence in the world today. In time will come to know the Holy Father and how he continues the crucial work of guiding the Church with his own style and personality rooted in his love for Christ.

This Good Shepherd Sunday is a prime opportunity for us to give thanks for the shepherds who have helped us to get where we are today. Yes, we are sheep, but we are also part shepherd. Let us ask God to give us the grace to be, by our word and example, good shepherds to others. Keeping our eyes and ears fixed on the Good Shepherd – the High Priest of us all, Jesus Christ – may we move forward in faith until we reach the heavenly pastures!

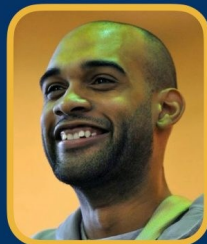

May 18, 2025

Fifth Sunday of Easter

John 13:31-33a, 34-35

When Judas had left them, Jesus said, "Now is the Son of Man glorified, and God is glorified in him. If God is glorified in him, God will also glorify him in himself, and God will glorify him at once. My children, I will be with you only a little while longer. I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another. This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

Reflection Questions

- Why does Jesus say "Now" the "Son of Man is glorified, and God is glorified in Him" ?
- How had Jesus shown love to his disciples at the Last Supper?
- How will people recognize Jesus' disciples?
- Jesus didn't just tell us to love one another. He showed us how to love one another. In what ways did Jesus show us how to love?
- When is it less difficult to show love to family members? When is it more difficult? When love is difficult, what do we do?

O my God, I love you above all things with my whole heart and soul, because you are all good and worthy of all my love. I love my neighbor as myself for the love of you. I forgive all who have injured me and I ask pardon of those whom I have injured.
