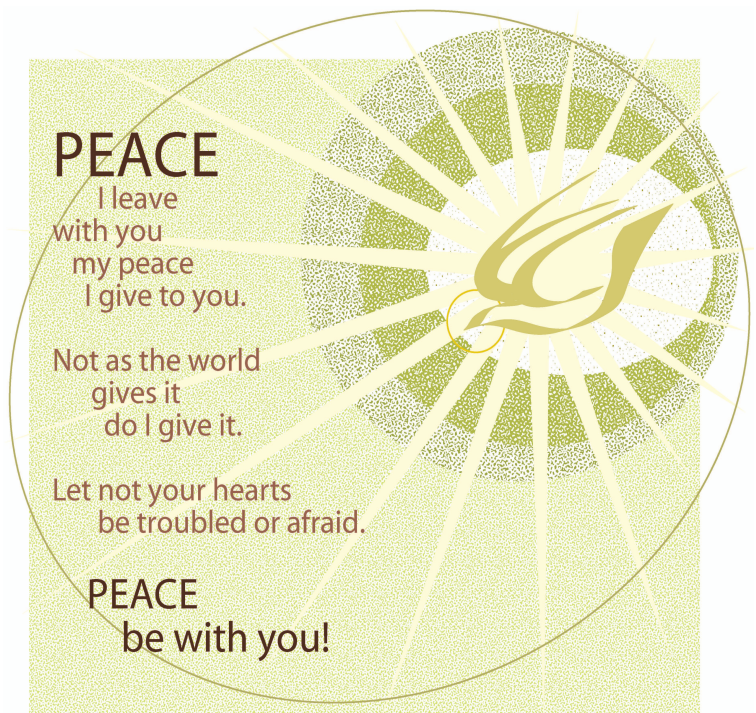

The Ascension of Our Lord celebrates the day that Christ, in the presence of His apostles, ascended bodily into Heaven.

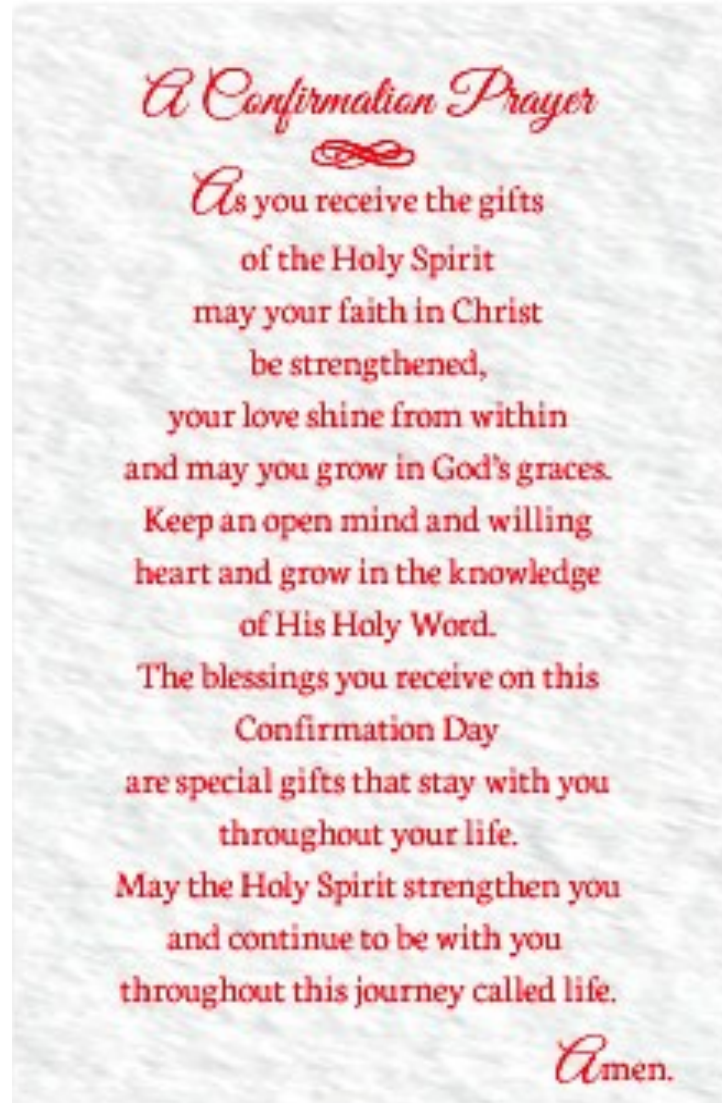

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

June 1, 2025

Seventh Sunday of Easter

John 17:20-26

Lifting up his eyes to heaven, Jesus prayed saying: "Holy Father, I pray not only for them, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, so that they may all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I in you, that they also may be in us, that the world may believe that you sent me. And I have given them the glory you gave me, so that they may be one, as we are one, I in them and you in me, that they may be brought to perfection as one, that the world may know that you sent me, and that you loved them even as you loved me. Father, they are your gift to me. I wish that where I am they also may be with me, that they may see my glory that you gave me, because you loved me before the foundation of the world. Righteous Father, the world also does not know you, but I know you, and they know that you sent me. I made known to them your name and I will make it known, that the love with which you loved me may be in them and I in them."

Reflection Questions

- How does Jesus extend in this passage His prayer to God the Father?
- What phrases in this passage describe Jesus' relationship with God the Father?
- What does Jesus think is more important than being popular in the eyes of the world?
- While unity demonstrates the Gospel to the world, what must be present for belief? Can you think of ways that you could personally contribute to greater unity in our church life?
- What barriers exist in your own life to "being one" with the rest of the body of Christ?
- Jesus says he "desires" for all believers to be with him. Do you share that same desire for people to be in a relationship in Jesus? Why or why not?

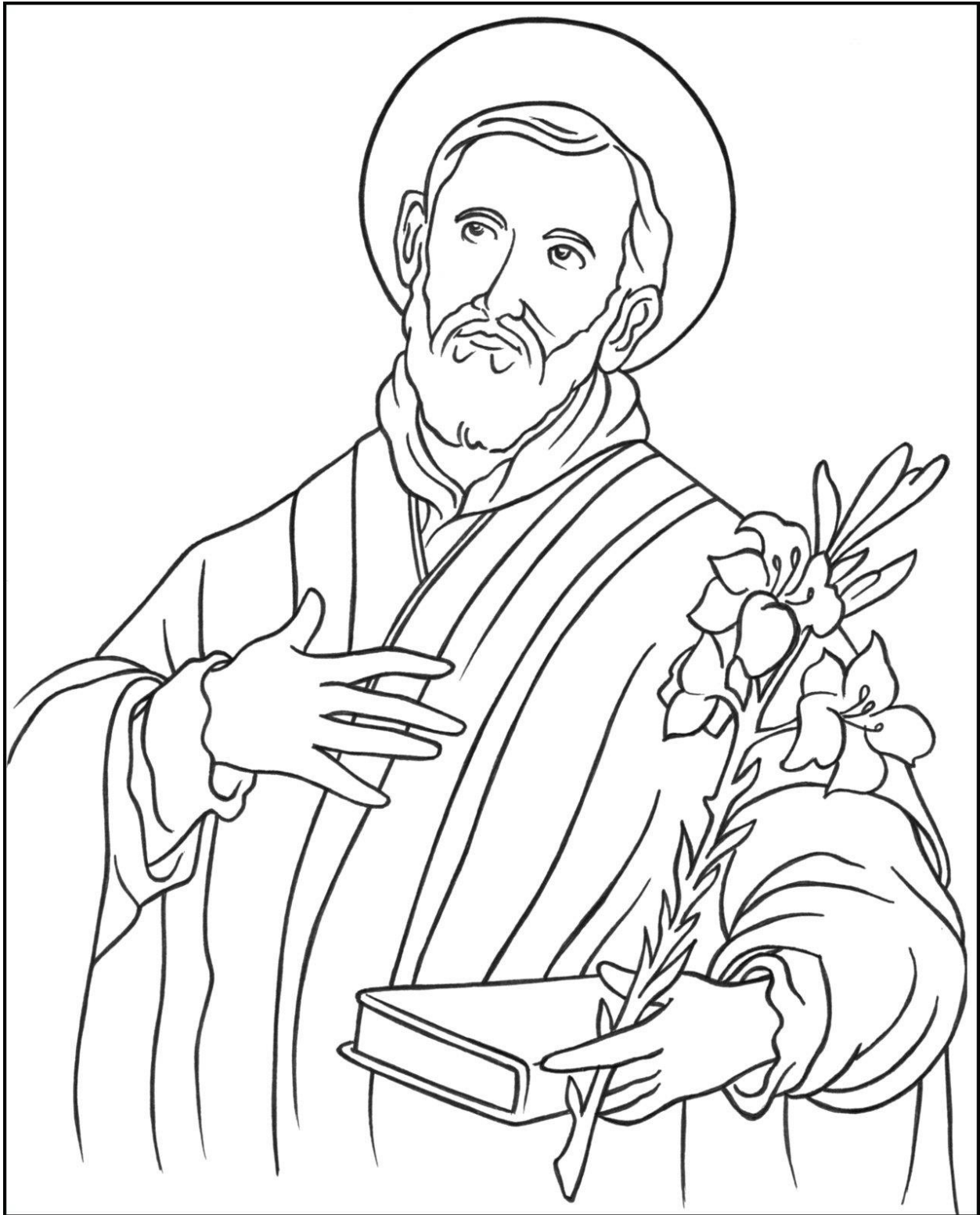
