## *A Message from our Pastor*



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

“God, where are you?”

How many times have we found ourselves thinking this or even saying it out loud? Just look at the world around us – the Middle East, Ukraine, Russia, unrest in major cities, divisions of all kinds. It’s no wonder that we might ask: “God, where are you?” In our own lives we can experience difficulties and challenges of all types that may leave us wondering if God has forgotten about us, or worse. Does God care?

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of *Corpus Christi*, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We hear in the Gospel of St. John how Jesus laid the groundwork for His most precious gift of the Eucharist. To feed hungry people, He performed a miracle! With merely a few loaves of bread and just a couple of fish, Jesus enabled the thousands present to eat. Not just a snack to tide them over until they could have a more substantial meal. No, He fed them until they were filled. So much so that there were enough leftovers to fill twelve baskets! We could say that this was Jesus’ way of saying, “I do care! I’m right here! I’m with you! In your hungers of heart and mind, in your anxieties and concerns – I am right here to fill you with everything you need!”

That’s what the Eucharist is – Jesus telling us that He’s right here with us. What a joy to know that every time we go to Mass, every time we set foot in a Catholic Church and see the tabernacle, we can know with confidence – He’s right here! Our God is not aloof or disinterested. St. Thomas Aquinas, in one of his most moving sermons on the Eucharist, said this: “As Jesus was at the point of leaving the world to go to the Father, after celebrating the Passover with his disciples, He left us a perpetual memorial of His passion. It was the fulfilment of ancient figures and the greatest of all His miracles, while for those who were to experience the sorrow of his departure, it was destined to be a unique and abiding consolation.” In other words, Jesus is right here with us whenever we need Him.

On a personal note, Fr. Matthew and I will each be making our annual retreat this coming week. Please say a prayer for us that it will be a time of spiritual renewal and refreshment. We’ll be back next Monday and look forward to seeing you then. Know of our gratitude and prayers for you.

The Church celebrates the Solemnity of Corpus Christi Sunday on June 22nd this year. The feast dates back to the 13th century when Pope Urban IV instituted it in 1264. It commemorates and emphasizes the belief in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. The term "Corpus Christi" is Latin for "Body of Christ." Holy devotion to Christ in the Blessed Sacrament is a common thread in the lives of the saints. We can look to their example and grow in our own relationship with Christ through the Body and Blood of our Lord.

Here are nine quotes from the saints on the Holy Eucharist:

"A thousand years of enjoying human glory is not worth even an hour spent sweetly communing with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament." -St. Padre Pio

"How many of you say: I should like to see His face, His garments, His shoes. You do see Him, you touch Him, you eat Him. He gives Himself to you, not only that you may see Him, but also to be your food and nourishment." - St. John Chrysostom

"God dwells in our midst, in the Blessed Sacrament of the altar." - St. Maximilian Kolbe

"Jesus has made Himself the Bread of Life to give us life. Night and day, He is there. If you really want to grow in love, come back to the Eucharist, come back to that Adoration." -St. Teresa of Calcutta

"The courage and strength that are in me are not of me, but of Him who lives in me – it is the Eucharist." -St. Faustina

"One of the most admirable effects of Holy Communion is to preserve the soul from sin, and to help those who fall through weakness to rise again. It is much more profitable, then, to approach this divine Sacrament with love, respect, and confidence, than to remain away through an excess of fear and scrupulosity." - St. Ignatius of Loyola

"If angels could be jealous of men, they would be so for one reason: Holy Communion." - St. Maximilian Kolbe

"Do you realize that Jesus is there in the tabernacle expressly for you - for you alone? He burns with the desire to come into your heart...don't listen to the demon, laugh at him, and go without fear to receive the Jesus of peace and love..." -St. Therese of Lisieux

"Always remain close to the Catholic Church, because it alone can give you true peace, since it alone possesses Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, the true Prince of Peace." - St. Padre Pio

## *Breaking Open the Word*

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

**June 29, 2025**

***The Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul***

***Matthew 16: 13-19***

When Jesus went into the region of Caesarea Philippi he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" They replied, "Some say John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Simon Peter said in reply, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus said to him in reply, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah. For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my heavenly Father. And so I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys to the Kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven."

### ***Reflection Questions***

- Where did Jesus go with his disciples? Where is that?
- What important question did Jesus ask his disciples? What answer did the disciples give Jesus?
- Who is building the church and on what would Jesus build it?
- This is the first time Jesus uses the word church. What does it mean? What do we learn about the church from this passage?
- What did Jesus warn his disciples about? Why?
- Who do you say Jesus is?
- Why is the question, "Who is Jesus?" so important for us to answer today?
- As you evaluate your own life, how would you answer the question Jesus asked Peter? "Who do you say that I am?" Why?
