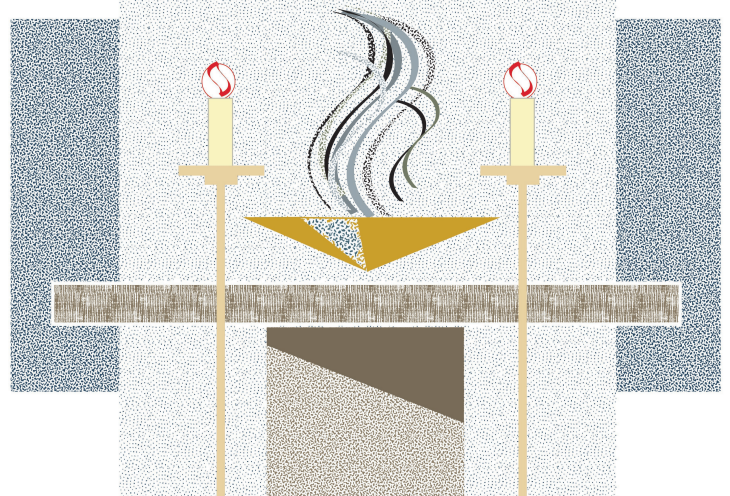

A Message from our Pastor



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I would like to update you on two items that impact our parishes. First, Fr. Gil Lap, who serves as the Pastor of St. Frances Cabrini Parish in Coram, has unfortunately become ill to the point that Bishop Barres has determined the need for an Administrator to be appointed in order that Fr. Gil can focus solely on his health and recovery and so that the pastoral needs of the parish be met effectively. Until Bishop Barres and Fr. Gil agree that he is able to return, I will be serving in that capacity – Parochial Administrator – for St. Frances Cabrini Parish. In other words, my slowly, but methodically, taking over the Catholic Church in Suffolk County is progressing well. (*I'm kidding, of course!*) But yes, this is a sizeable additional responsibility for me, but I am grateful for the assistance of the clergy and staff at all three parishes. And please, keep Fr. Gil in your prayers for a full and speedy recovery so that he can return to his beloved flock in Coram.

Secondly, when Fr. Grieco arrived at our parishes in January 2025, it was thought that he would likely be departing this summer for a new pastoral assignment. Owing to the long-range pastoral planning for clergy assignments and the current needs of our two parishes, Fr. Grieco will be remaining at St. Gerard's and Infant Jesus until Bishop Barres appoints him elsewhere. We are grateful for Fr. Grieco's pastoral charity and look forward to continuing to collaborate with him in service of our parishioners.

We are in the midst of the First Holy Communion season at our parish. We had two celebrations last weekend and one more next Saturday. This is always an exciting time for our children and their families as they encounter Jesus in the most intimate and sacred way possible – taking into their bodies and hearts the very Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of our Savior. Over these weeks, as you see the children at Sunday Mass in their lovely dresses and suits, try to congratulate them personally on this milestone in their sacramental lives. Also, allow their exuberance to inspire within you a renewal in your love and appreciation for the Blessed Sacrament. To that end, may I remind you that we have our monthly Holy Hour this Thursday at 7:00pm at St. Gerard's. In addition to receiving Holy Communion at Mass, spending time before Our Lord in Eucharistic Adoration is a tremendously powerful way to grow in grace and virtue. I like to think of adoration as a type of “divine radiation treatment.” Just as our bodies are changed when we are in the sun or receive a medical radiation treatment, so too our souls are changed by simply being in the radiant presence of the Lord. After all our words are spoken, after we lay bare before Jesus all that we're carrying in our hearts, we sit with Him and allow His divine mercy and love to wash over us and bring us a peace that only He can deliver.

May you and your families enjoy the beautiful Spring weather this week! Know of my prayers for you and your intentions. Please keep me in yours!

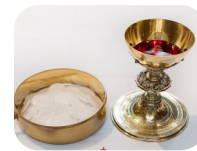

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

May 10, 2026

Sixth Sunday of Easter

John 14:15-21

Jesus said to his disciples:

"If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot accept, because it neither sees nor knows him. But you know him, because he remains with you, and will be in you. I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you. In a little while the world will no longer see me, but you will see me, because I live and you will live. On that day you will realize that I am in my Father and you are in me and I in you. Whoever has my commandments and observes them is the one who loves me. And whoever loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and reveal myself to him."

Reflection Questions

- How does Jesus want us to express our "love" (John 14:15) for Him? What is the flipside of what He said in John 14:15?
- Who is the "Spirit of truth" (John 14:17)? When will God the Father "give" (John 14:16) the Spirit? Where is the Holy Spirit today?
- How long did Jesus mean by "a little while" (John 14:19)? What will His resurrection prove to them?
- Identify a time when you were struggling in some way and the Holy Spirit provided help to you. What did that help look like? Working out circumstances? Bringing someone along to help? Inner strength and peace? A still small voice of encouragement?
- Jesus declares he will not leave the disciples as orphans but will come to them. He obviously did this after he rose from the dead. But since Jesus' teaching also applies to us, those who come after, how does Jesus come to us? How does Jesus make his presence known to us?
- Three times in v. 20 Jesus uses the preposition "in": he is in the Father, we are in him, and he is in us. In each of these uses "in" means to be in union with, or even enveloped within. Being "in" Jesus, then, is more than just saying a simple prayer; if we are in union with Jesus or enveloped within him, we are in lock-step with him, we are connected to him Does this make more sense of Jesus' command that if we love him we will obey him? If we don't obey him how can we say we are in union with him or are connected to him?

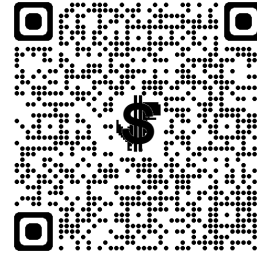

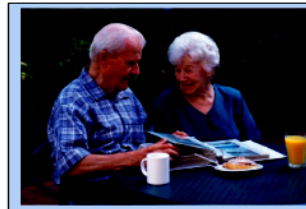

Charitable Donations



The IRA Charitable Rollover is back and is now permanent!

What's called a rollover is actually a "qualified charitable distribution" that can be made to our Parish.

If...

1. You are at least 70 1/2 years old on the date you make your gift
2. Your IRA is a traditional or Roth
3. You don't exceed your personal maximum of \$100,000 per year in qualified charitable distributions

You will not have to report your distribution as income. It will be free of federal and New York State income tax, and it will count toward your required minimum distribution (RMD).

The best way for you to start is with your IRA custodian. Tell them you want to make a "qualified charitable distribution". In most cases you will only have to fill out a simple form.

VERY IMPORTANT!! Your gift must go directly from your IRA to the Parish. If you receive the money first then you'll be taxed on it like any other distribution.

Example: Mrs. Connors, age 76, has \$125,000 in a traditional IRA and would like to contribute \$5,000 to her Parish in 2016. Upon hearing of the Charitable IRA Rollover opportunity, she directs the custodian of her IRA to transfer this amount not later than December 31, 2016 directly to the Parish as a 2016 gift. She will not be subject to income tax on her \$5,000 qualified charitable distribution.

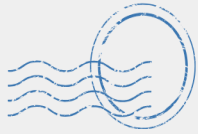

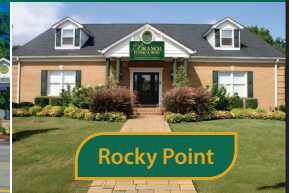

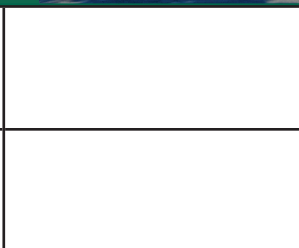
