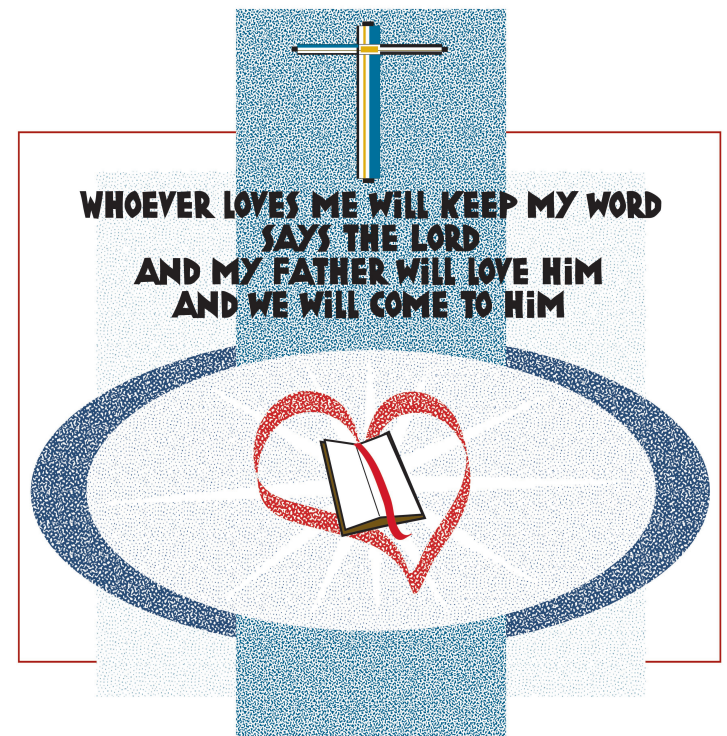

A Message from our Pastor



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace and peace to you in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ! As we gather in this beautiful month of May, our hearts are drawn to two profound and intertwined blessings: the gift of our mothers and the tender, guiding presence of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

First, I wish to extend to all the mothers in our parish a joyful and heartfelt Mother's Day. Whether you are a mother, grandmother, godmother, or a spiritual mother who nurtures others in faith and love, your witness is a reflection of God's own care and compassion. The sacrifices you make, often unseen, and the love you give so freely are powerful testimonies to the life-giving grace of God. 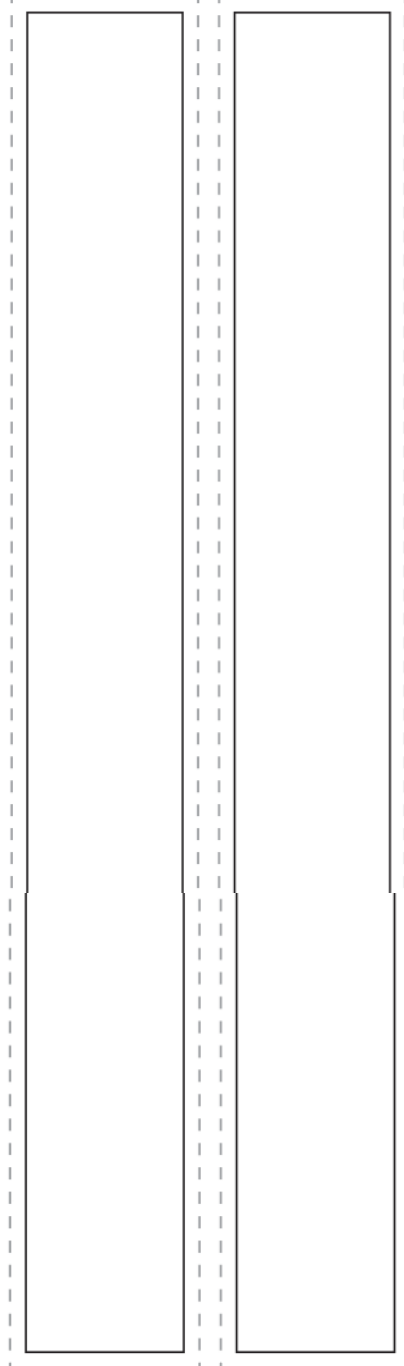

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of the Liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

May 17, 2026

Seventh Sunday of Easter

John 17:1-11a

Jesus raised his eyes to heaven and said, "Father, the hour has come. Give glory to your son, so that your son may glorify you, just as you gave him authority over all people, so that your son may give eternal life to all you gave him. Now this is eternal life, that they should know you, the only true God, and the one whom you sent, Jesus Christ. I glorified you on earth by accomplishing the work that you gave me to do. Now glorify me, Father, with you, with the glory that I had with you before the world began. "I revealed your name to those whom you gave me out of the world. They belonged to you, and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word. Now they know that everything you gave me is from you, because the words you gave to me I have given to them, and they accepted them and truly understood that I came from you, and they have believed that you sent me. I pray for them. I do not pray for the world but for the ones you have given me, because they are yours, and everything of mine is yours and everything of yours is mine, and I have been glorified in them. And now I will no longer be in the world, but they are in the world, while I am coming to you."

- Who did Jesus intercede for in His prayer and what did He ask God to do for them?

- Does Jesus say that they believe He is the Messiah who would die for their sins and be resurrected?
- After reading Jesus' prayer, how does it make you feel about the power of prayer? How does it make you feel that the One we believe, trust and worship as our Savior, prayed for us when He was fully human walking on earth?

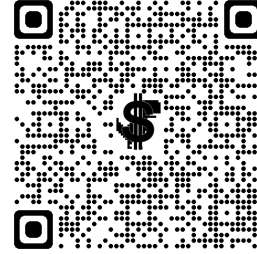

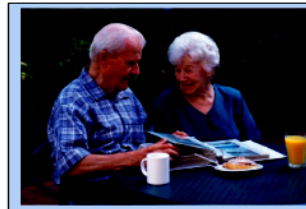

Charitable Donations



The IRA Charitable Rollover is back and is now permanent!

What's called a rollover is actually a "qualified charitable distribution" that can be made to our Parish.

If...

1. You are at least 70 1/2 years old on the date you make your gift
2. Your IRA is a traditional or Roth
3. You don't exceed your personal maximum of \$100,000 per year in qualified charitable distributions

You will not have to report your distribution as income. It will be free of federal and New York State income tax, and it will count toward your required minimum distribution (RMD).

The best way for you to start is with your IRA custodian. Tell them you want to make a "qualified charitable distribution". In most cases you will only have to fill out a simple form.

VERY IMPORTANT!! Your gift must go directly from your IRA to the Parish. If you receive the money first then you'll be taxed on it like any other distribution.

Example: Mrs. Connors, age 76, has \$125,000 in a traditional IRA and would like to contribute \$5,000 to her Parish in 2016. Upon hearing of the Charitable IRA Rollover opportunity, she directs the custodian of her IRA to transfer this amount not later than December 31, 2016 directly to the Parish as a 2016 gift. She will not be subject to income tax on her \$5,000 qualified charitable distribution.

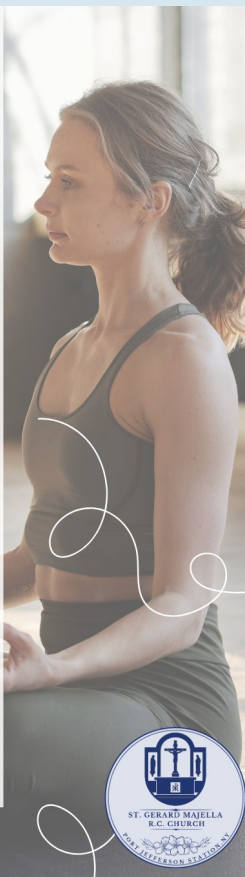
PIETRA FITNESS

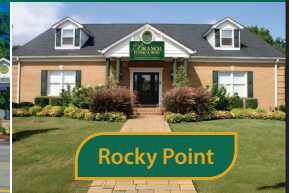
